## The Pastor's Corner

Dear Friends,

Once again we celebrate Memorial Day weekend.

Memorial Day is when we honor and mourn members of the military who, while serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, passed away. These men and women gave their lives for their nation while protecting and serving it.

The biggest funeral Mass I attended was 15 or so years ago in Colville for a young man who died while serving our nation. The Church was packed, people were spilling outside the doors, and the town honored him by lining up along Main Street. The deceased was a young man in his early 20s and the town loved him and his family. What a sad time it was for all of us. And at the same time it brought us close together as we remembered his life growing up in Colville, his deep Catholic faith, and his willingness to always want to serve.

Many years prior his death, his family had me over for dinner. I had given their son (a teenager at the time) a small crucifix that was blessed by Pope John Paul II (now St. John Paul II). I had forgotten about it until I heard, in the funeral homily, that the young man died with the crucifix in his pocket. His dad reported that he always carried that crucifix on his person.

My story is far from being unique. Most of us have a story or two of a loved one, friend, or acquaintance who died while serving in the U.S. Armed forces. This is a special time when we remember them and thank Almighty God for their life. May their souls now rest eternally in peace.
