

Seminarian Formation Appeal



All parishioners should have received a mailing from Bishop Daly with information about this year's Seminarian Formation Appeal. It begins the weekend of June 14-15, 2025.

The Diocese of Spokane in blessed to have 19 men in Seminary formation. The path to priesthood can be nine years for a seminarian who begins at Corpus Christi, continuing his studies at Bishop White Seminary, and then finishing theological studies at one of the three major seminaries the men are sent to. The cost to form a seminarian over a nine-year period can exceed \$400,000.
