There is a plenary indulgence attached with praying the Rosary. The 4 conditions to gaining this plenary indulgence are:

- 1. Pray the 5 decades without interruption.
- 2. Pray the prayers and meditate on the mysteries.
- 3. Announce the mysteries if the prayer is public.
- 4. Go to Confession, receive Communion, pray for the Pope's intention, and be detached from sin.
