November 2nd is All Souls' Day, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. We remember and pray for the holy souls in purgatory.

Please take good care of yourselves during these cold days. It seems like winter, but fall has barely just begun. A reminder: if you are not feeling well and/or are coming down with a cold or have flu symptoms, please refrain from drinking the precious blood of Christ from the chalice at communion time. It is also very appropriate to refrain from shaking hands during the sign of peace. A simple head bow to the folks next to you is acceptable and a blessing. Missing Mass on the weekend if you are sick is not a sin; most all of you, if not all of you, know this – but it is worth repeating.
