Dear Friends,

Warm and prayerful Advent greetings to you and all your loved ones.

At the beginning of this month, I present the intentions of Pope Leo XIV. He asks for prayers each month for a particular intention. His intention for December is:

"Let us pray that Christians living in areas of war or conflict, especially in the Middle East, might be seeds of peace, reconciliation, and hope,"

Each year on December 8th we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a holy day of obligation and we will celebrate the mass on Monday at 8:30 am and 5:30 pm.

Please take good care of yourselves during these cold days. Remember if you are not feeling well and/or are coming down with a cold or have any flu symptoms, please refrain from drinking the precious blood of Christ from the chalice at communion time. It is also very appropriate to refrain from shaking hands during the sign of peace. A simple head bow to the folks next to you is acceptable and a blessing.

Also, you will soon be receiving the Christmas schedule and will note that there is not going to be an Advent Reconciliation Service this year but there are added extra times for private confessions.
