Dear Parishioners:

What a great celebration we had last Sunday of our Parish Feast Day as we honored our Patron

Saint, Saint Martin de Porres, and celebrated our beautiful parish that bears his name. It was also an occasion to give thanks to Almighty God for all of you who make this Parish such a beautiful place to be. A special thank you to Maureen Schade and our Social Committee and all the volunteers for all their hard work and long hours in providing the receptions after the morning Masses for us to spend some time together as a parish family.

We also had the privilege as a Country this past week on Friday, November 11th, to honor our Veterans. How grateful we are for all those heroic men and women throughout the history of our great Nation up to today who served in our armed forces and fought in wars so heroically, so courageously, and so selflessly so that we could live in a Country that is free. Our School sponsored a Mass for our Veterans last Thursday and hosted them for a luncheon in our school with presentations and songs by our children in gratitude to our Veterans. How important it is for our children to learn of and appreciate the sacrifices so many have made, even of their very lives, for the freedom we enjoy today. Our Veterans embody the values of Faith, Family, Patriotism, Service, and Sacrifice that made this country great. What a great lesson for our children.

As we approach the end of the Liturgical Year with the Feast of Christ the King next week and a brand new year beginning with Advent only two weeks away, our readings at this time of year focus on the end, on the "Four Last Things" – Death, Judgment, Heaven and Hell – and our need to be ready at any time for the coming of our Lord. For, as St. Paul reminds us, we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ to give an accounting of our lives and we know not the day or the hour.

Today's Gospel is a bit unsettling. Jesus uses a lot of highly symbolic language that is hard to understand called *Apocalyptic Literature*. It all sounds like gloom and doom, but it is really meant to be for the early Christians undergoing great persecution a message of hope and expectation. It is meant to be an encouragement to remain faithful, to persevere without getting discouraged, for the ultimate Victory is already won.

All the destruction and tribulations Jesus speaks of in today's Gospel are images of the clash between good and evil as the new order, the Reign of God, clashes with and overcomes the old order, the Reign of Satan, which was accomplished definitively by Jesus on the Cross. Jesus is saying these things at the end of His earthly life when His Passion and Death was close at hand. Jesus' victory over the reign of Satan would be preceded by a

wave of tremendous suffering and tribulation for him in His Passion and Death. And Jesus wanted his disciples to know that they would have to bear their share of the Cross in this world in order to share in the Victory of His Resurrection.

"By your PERSEVERANCE you will save your life," Jesus says. For the Death and Resurrection of Jesus assures us that evil, suffering, and death are only for a time. For those who remain faithful and persevere in faith to the end, Jesus promises a share in His victory of Good over evil, of Love over hate, of Life over death. And through it all Jesus assures us that He is with us always. May we always remain with Him. May God bless us all.
