Dear Parishioners:

So much preparation and planning go on here during the summer, especially for the return of

our children to our School and our Religious Education Program. There will be a change in our Religious Ed Office this fall as our Administrative Assistant, Mrs. Ann Marie Pagano, has decided to retire at the end of the August after seven of years of hard work and devoted service to our children and families. Her retirement is well deserved, however, we will miss her kind presence in the office every day and her untiring dedication. Thank God Mrs. Pagano is not leaving our Parish as she is a faithful Parishioner, but she leaves our Religious Education Program with our love, our gratitude, and our prayers.

There is no more important work we could be engaged in, especially in these times, than the religious formation of our children. They learn so many important things in school, but without faith, without knowing the Lord Jesus and following in His ways, it will ultimately do them little good. Our young people are thirsting for the Truth, thirsting for Jesus Christ, and once they find Him they will have everything they need to be happy and successful in the things that matter most.

This is what Jesus is saying to us in today's Gospel. He is warning us about being filled with the things of the world, but empty of the things that matter most to God. Jesus tells a parable about a man who was "foolish" because he thought he could be secure and happy by storing up possessions for himself. But as the old saying goes, "you can't take it with you." The things of the world are good in themselves, but we are not wired for them, we are wired for God. One day we will be summoned to give an accounting of our lives before God, and at that moment God will not be interested in how rich we were in the things of the world, but in how rich we were in things like faith, hope, love, mercy, compassion, integrity, humility, honesty, virtue, and self-giving.

In the opening ceremonies of World Youth Day in Madrid, Spain, several years ago Pope Francis said to the young people gathered there: "Today it would be good for all of us to ask ourselves sincerely: "In whom do we place our trust? In ourselves, in material things, or in Jesus? We all have the temptation often...to believe that we alone build our lives or to think that our life can only be happy if built on possessions, money, pleasure or power. But we all know that it is not so. Certainly, possessions, money, pleasures and power can give a momentary thrill, the illusion of being happy, but they end up possessing us and making us always want to have more, never satisfied. Put on Christ in

your life, place your trust in Him and you will never be disappointed."

As Saint Augustin put it: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you." Let us pray that the restless hearts of our young people will come to discover this great truth. May they and all of us never be counted among the "foolish," but rather among the "wise" who know what is truly valuable and strive to become rich in the things that matter most to God. May God bless us all.

Any Couples Married Outside the Church – Let Us Help You Con-Validate Your Marriage

The Bible speaks about marriage and what God intended for marriage from the beginning. Jesus and the Church He founded recognize the pain of divorce. Many believe that being divorced separates them from the Church and the ability to receive Holy Communion. This is not the case. The problem arises when one is divorced and then remarried outside the Church. A valid Marriage is until "death do us part." Therefore, one who was validly married and then divorced cannot be married again in the Church unless it is determined that the prior marriage was null and void from the beginning because the consent, out of which a valid marriages arises, was defective for some reason. This is the process of applying for what is popularly called an Annulment. If you find yourself in the position of having been married outside the Church (a civil marriage) because you or your spouse were previously divorced, please contact one of us priests. We can help you through the process of petitioning for a Church Annulment so that you are free to marry in the Church. We will then help you to have your current marriage convalidated, that is, made valid in the eyes of the Church and Sacramental, so that you can return to Holy Communion. For anyone in a civil marriage who was never married before but just wasn't married in the Church, also please see a priest to help you have your marriage con-validated. Too many are living without the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony and we are here to help you. We need the Grace of the Sacraments to remain faithful. 426deporrespage5


