Dear Parishioners.

With Labor Day coming next weekend, the summer has truly flown

by. It was so good to have Fr. Benedict with us this summer. He returns home this week, on August 30th. Fr. Benedict is such a good, humble, holy, and faithful priest and a great friend. I pray he will return to us next summer. It has also been a special blessing to have Fr. Abraham with us this past month. He will be with us for another week or so. Fr. Abraham is so beloved here and is always at home at St. Martin de Porres. He is another great priest and good friend. Soon after Labor Day it will be just Fr. Charles and I striving to serve our parish to the best of our ability. I thank God for Fr. Charles who is such a tremendous blessing to this parish, a great priest, and a dear friend.

At the heart of our mission here is to bring us all closer to Jesus - to come to know and love Him more and more so that we can be more like Him and share His Love with others. The parable Jesus gives us in today's Gospel teaches us much about who He is and what it means to be like Him. Using the image of a wedding banquet, which is an image of Heaven, Jesus says to his disciples: "When you are invited to a wedding, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes he may invite you to take a higher place." When Jesus speaks of taking the "lowest place," He is speaking first of all about Himself, about the Incarnation – the marriage of God and humanity in the one Divine Person of the Son of God.

Jesus, the Son of God, came down from the highest place in Heaven to become one of us, uniting our lowly human nature to His Divine Nature. He humbled himself, taking the "lowest place among us." He came all the way down from Heaven to be born in a dirty, cold stable in Bethlehem; He bent all the way down to wash the feet of His disciples (a task assigned to a slave); He lowered Himself so much as to accept the most humiliating and agonizing death on the Cross; He descended all the way from the heights of Heaven to the depths of the grave in order to lift us up to the heights of Heaven.

When we look upon the humility of the Son of God, we see how unjust it is when mere human beings are filled with pride, arrogance, self-importance, hatred, and prejudice; when we hold on to anger and hurt and refuse to forgive others as He has forgiven us. We need to look to Jesus who took the "lowest place" on the Cross and in the midst of all His hurt said: "Father, forgive them." That is humility.

Humility is what makes us most like Jesus. "Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto thine." May God bless us all.



#### <u>Any Couples Married Outside the Church</u> – Let Us Help You Con-Validate Your Marriage

The Bible speaks about marriage and what God intended for marriage from the beginning. Jesus and the Church He founded recognize the pain of divorce. Many believe that being divorced separates them from the Church and the ability to receive Holy Communion. This is not the case. The problem arises when one is divorced and then remarried outside the Church. A valid Marriage is until "death do us part." Therefore, one who was validly married and then divorced cannot be married again in the Church unless it is determined that the prior marriage was null and void from the beginning because the consent, out of which a valid marriages arises, was defective for some reason. This is the process of applying for what is popularly called an Annulment. If you find yourself in the position of having been married outside the Church (a civil marriage) because you or your spouse were previously divorced, please contact one of us priests. We can help you through the process of petitioning for a Church Annulment so that you are free to marry in the Church. We will then help you to have your current marriage con-validated, that is, made valid in the eyes of the Church and Sacramental, so that you can return to Holy Communion. For anyone in a civil marriage who was never married before but just wasn't married in the Church, also please see a priest to help you have your marriage con-validated. Too many are living without the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony and we are here to help you. We need the Grace of the Sacraments to remain faithful.


