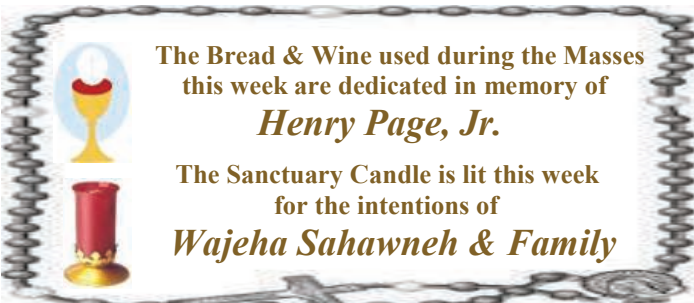

Students wishing to enter grades 1-7 must also provide recent report cards and standardized/NYS test results. There is a \$125 non-refundable fee for each registrant.

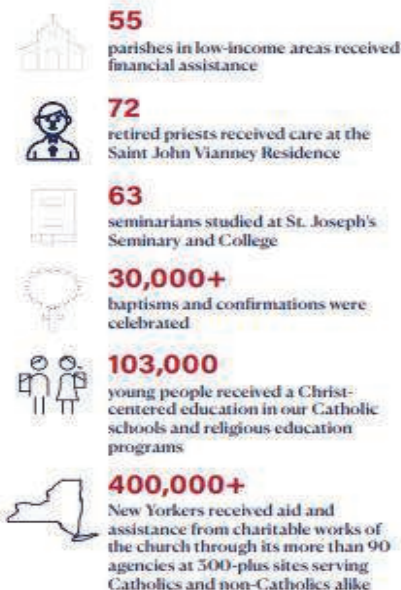
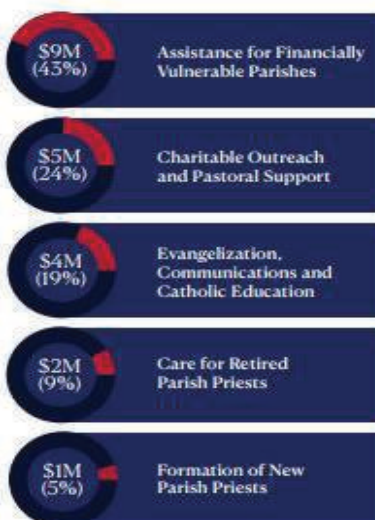
