Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

I want to say thanks to each of you who have already contributed to our Cardinal's Annual Stewardship Appeal. As of now, 154 families and individuals have pledged \$98,310. This is a good start towards our goal of \$135,500, but we hope for more people to participate. Please examine your sacrifices for Lent. We are all obliged - for our own spiritual good as well as for the practical benefit of others - to do three things during Lent: **more praying, more giving up, more giving to.** In your almsgiving this Lent, when you are deciding what to give to, see this Appeal as a good opportunity to offer significant help to others.

To make giving easy and simple, we have Cardinal's Appeal envelopes in the pews and vestibules today. Use one to mail your Lenten sacrifice, and be sure to indicate that you are a member of our parish. Or send your check in any envelope to: The Cardinal's Appeal, 1011 First Av, NY 10022.

This Lent, all of us priests and all of you who love our Church are laboring under a cloud of hurt and suspicion because of allegations about priests who harmed young people and adults, and questions about how these matters were handled. This could affect your presence at Mass and/or your financial support for our parish and for other appeals. Therefore I want to give you a copy of the message from Cardinal Dolan when he established the Independent Reconciliation and Compensation Program to help victims have some healing and justice. This is what he said then, and reiterates now, about the uses of your donations:

"You may wonder - since it is your money - where the revenue to cover this compensation will come from. I can tell you where it will <u>not</u> come from: it will <u>not</u> come from the money you have given to your parishes and schools, nor will it come from the archdiocese in our Cardinal's Annual Stewardship Appeal, nor from our Renew and Rebuild capital campaign, nor from Catholic Charities or any other apostolate you intend your generous offerings to support."

To provide these settlements, the archdiocese has borrowed money against the land it owns under the Palace Hotel across from Saint Patrick's Cathedral. We will repay that loan with sale of other property over time. I assure you that the contributions you make to our parish on Sundays or this coming Easter, or to the charitable Cardinal's Appeal, or to our Renew+Rebuild campaign that we need to air-condition our gym: all will be used for promised and usual purposes, not for payments or settlements.

One of the Cardinal's Appeal purposes is the support of our school for future priests (and deacons). We were very happy to have a seminarian from Dunwoodie - Saint Joseph Seminary in Yonkers - working with us last summer for several months. Brother Bobby Carolan, with his enthusiasm and friendliness, made a very positive impression on all of us. He still asks for our prayers so that he can go all the way to ordination. Men like him will help to bring new life to our parishes, so pray for him and for all those who are answering God's call to explore their possible vocation to priesthood for the people of New York.

This week you can see Brother Bobby on TV! In keeping with the ideal of giving priests-in-training a variety of geographic and pastoral experiences, this summer Brother Bobby will serve at St. Mary's Parish in Poughkeepsie. But producers from the Catholic Faith Network (on all three cable systems that serve Staten Island) recently did a number of profiles called "St. Joseph Seminary: Forming the Future." An episode that features Brother Bobby will air this week and be repeated next week.

The times I received from the Catholic Faith Network for this program are: TUESDAY APRIL 2 at 11am, WEDNESDAY APRIL 3 at 9:30pm, TUESDAY APRIL 9 at 11am. and WEDNESDAY APRIL 10 at 9:30pm. The Catholic Faith Network can be found on Spectrum channel 471. It is also on Cablevision 137 and Verizon 296.

And if you watch, you may see some other parish people too. A crew from CFN came here to do filming about our Sister Margaret Mary Food Pantry. We have wonderful people who volunteer there with kindness and respect for all who come for help. As the producer: wrote to me: "Please thank Mary Anne Christoffersen and Kathleen Fawcett. They were great!"

While you are looking for more things uplifting and important, also check the excellent offerings from our Brooklyn neighbors at NET - New Evangelization Television. They show several Masses at various times each day, including Mass from St. Patrick's Cathedral. There is also a nightly news program, and a very enjoyable weekly program with Cardinal Dolan. NET can be found on these channels: Spectrum 97, Cablevision 30, Verizon 48. And always think of EWTN - the Eternal Word Television Network, channel 460 on Spectrum - founded by Mother Angelica. EWTN has provided years of Catholic presence and conversation and prayer support for Catholics and non Catholics alike.
