Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

This start of summer could be a very good time for you to simplify the way you give your weekly support for our parish. Go to our website—www.saintteresasi.org—to the WESHARE ONLINE GIVING to see how easy and beneficial it can be for you to donate this way, as dozens already do.

Our parishioners are consistently generous in giving to our Sunday collections for the ordinary expenses of our parish. Additional proof of your awareness of the needs of others and your willingness to be sharers of your blessings has been the extraordinary level of support from our parishioners for this year's Cardinal's Appeal. The participation rate and the amount donated has exceeded the results of recent years - and we know from the past that more contributions will trickle in during the summer and fall. I thank everyone who has and who will - through this annual **Cardinal's Stewardship Appeal** - do for others what they cannot do for themselves. I am very pleased to report that as of May 24, \$125,840 has been pledged by the people of our parish.242 gifts have been received, and we are within ten thousand dollars of our parish goal of \$135,500.

As you probably know, Scouting has been an important part of Youth Ministry in our parish for many years, helping boys and girls and their parents and families to be part of something that develops their self-esteem and perseverance and social skills. (One example of perseverance was the delayed-for-several-Sundays-by-rain-sale of Girl Scout cookies after Masses.) Many thanks to all of you who stop on these Sundays and buy the cookies or baked goods that help our youth organizations to defray the cost of their trips and equipment.

I especially admire our Scout leaders for their commitment to use all the projects and badges that draw the attention of Scouts to their Catholic values and practice. On Sunday April 7, many Scouts and their families attended a special Mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral sponsored by the Archdiocese's Catholic Committee on Scouting. Auxiliary Bishop Dominic Lagonegro presided and told his own story about Scouting. Troop 37 of Saint Teresa Parish was well represented at the awards ceremony that followed the Mass, thanks especially to the encouragement of Assistant Scoutmaster Steven Jerome.

Receiving the **AD ALTARE DEI** Emblem, signifying the importance of coming to the Altar of God and developing a fully active Catholic way of life, were Scouts Jarod Carp, Shane Gallagher, Trevor Lichtensteiger, Nico Mineo, Sandun Perera, Sunka Perera, and Christopher Pfuhler.

The **POPE PIUS XII** Emblem honors the memory of a great Pope who believed in the moral goodness of young people and was a staunch supporter of the Scouting movement. This emblem focuses on the importance of a person's life choices (single, married, religious, ordained) and seeing their occupations and ministries as calls from God. Receiving this emblem were Andrew Asher, Thomas Boyer, David LaGanga, Dante Mineo, and Matthew Pfuhler.

The **BRONZE PELICAN** AWARD was created in our Archdiocese in 1950 and has been adopted across the country to recognize outstanding contributions to the spiritual development of Catholic youth through Boy Scouts of America. I am grateful to those who nominated me for this award. I am proud to receive it and to be associated with this important ministry.

Good lessons and good friends, such as people find in Scouting, can prepare us for extraordinary tests in life. You may have heard about a tragic shooting on the campus of the University of North Carolina in Charlotte on April 30. Two people were killed, and four were wounded. The police officer who found the shooter and disarmed him was a former parishioner and member of Boy Scout of Troop 37, Richard Gundacker. From Wikipedia: "UNC Charlotte Police Sergeant Richard Gundacker was the first of the officers to enter the building. According to an affidavit submitted to a magistrate, Gundacker entered Room 236 and yelled to the survivors to identify the suspected gunman, who then identified himself. Gundacker, who prior to joining the UNC Charlotte Police had retired from the New York City Police Department in 2015 as a detective, was able to disarm the suspected gunman, recovering the Glock pistol he had used along with multiple gun magazines."

Sgt. Gundacker's parents, longtime former Scoutmaster Richard Gondacker and his wife Mary, told me about this the next Sunday. They were so grateful to God that their son had not been wounded or killed when he sought the shooter. His valor in facing the threat and his skill in disarming the man were vital to the safety of others. But as he told his father, "I have been preparing for this kind of an event for 25 years." Maybe that preparation began even earlier, when he was learning how to be a Boy Scout here with us. And let us not forget the prayers of his family for his protection through all those years as well.





Congratulations and God's blessings to all parishioners who are graduating this spring from schools at every level, including College, High School, Elementary School, Kindergarten and Prek. Our young Graduates have studied, played, learned, and grown very much! May they love Jesus Christ and become good disciples, for their own benefit and the good of the whole world.
