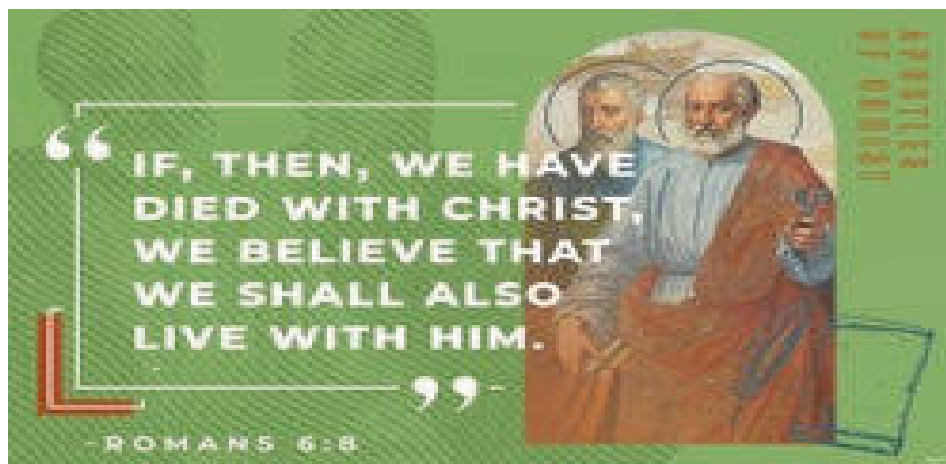

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

Praying at Mass and receiving Holy Communion are truly important parts of a grace-filled life for all who are able to gather. Devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist is so important for dealing with temptations and troubles, and for getting and staying on the highway to heaven. Therefore I offer you this report with a message from Pope Francis to Catholic people in the United States, encouraging us to have a personal and national EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL.

ZENIT News / Vatican City, 06.19.2023). On Monday morning, June 19, Pope Francis received in audience the members of the Organizing Committee of the United States National Eucharistic Congress, which will be held from July 17-21, 2024, in Indianapolis. (Foreseen is the participation of some 80,000 American Catholics. Visit the official website: www.eucharisticrevival.org) Here is the English translation, with editing to fit this space, of the Pope's address.

I am pleased to give you a warm welcome, members of the Organizing Committee of the next National Eucharistic Congress of the United States of America. I thank you for all that you do and I encourage you to continue your efforts to revive faith in and love for the Most Holy Eucharist, which is "the source and summit of all Christian life."

Read again the story of the multiplication of loaves in John's Gospel, chapter 6. The miracle's witnesses returned to the Lord the next day, hoping to see Him work another sign. However, Christ wanted to transform their material hunger into another hunger, for the Bread of eternal life (cf. John 6:26-27). Hence, Jesus spoke of Himself as the living bread come down from Heaven, the true bread that gives life to the world (cf. John 6:51).

*When I was celebrating Mass this morning, I thought a lot about this, because the Eucharist is what gives us life. In fact, **the Eucharist is God's answer to the most profound hunger of the human heart, the hunger of true life:** in It Christ Himself is really in our midst to feed us, to console us and to sustain us on our journey.*

*Unfortunately, some people believe that the Eucharist is more a symbol than the real and loving presence of the Lord. But the Eucharist is more than a symbol. **It is the real and loving presence of the Lord.** Hence, I hope that the Eucharistic Congress will inspire Catholics of your whole country to recover their wonder and astonishment before this great gift that the Lord has given us. **So: spend time with Him in the celebration of Holy Mass, in personal prayer, and in Adoration of the Most Holy Sacrament.***

*I think that in this modern time we have lost the sense of Adoration. It is a prayer that we've lost, and you, Bishops, must catechize the faithful about the prayer of Adoration; the Eucharist asks this of us. **And I cannot fail to mention the necessity to promote vocations to the Priesthood. As Saint John Paul II said: "Without the Priesthood there is no Eucharist"** (Letter to Priests for Holy Thursday 2004). **Priests are needed to celebrate the Sacred Eucharist.***

*I trust that this Congress will be an occasion for all the faithful to commit themselves with ever greater zeal to be missionary disciples of the Lord Jesus in the world. In the Eucharist we meet Jesus Who gave Himself wholly, Who sacrificed Himself to give us life, Who loved us to the extreme. **We become credible witnesses of the joy and transforming beauty of the Gospel only by recognizing that the love celebrated in the Sacrament cannot be kept for ourselves, but calls to be shared with all.***

*Missionary work consists in this: you go to Mass, you go to Communion, you adore . . . And then? **Then you go out, you go out to evangelize.** Jesus "makes" us do this. The Eucharist impels us to have a love strongly committed to our neighbors, because we cannot understand and truly live its significance if we keep our hearts closed to our brothers, especially to the poor, to the suffering, to the exhausted or lost in life. Two groups of people come to mind that we must always visit: the elderly, who are the wisdom of a people, and the sick, who are the figure of the suffering Jesus.*

Dear friends, the National Eucharistic Congress marks a significant moment in the life of the Church in the United States.** May everything you do be an occasion of grace for each one of you, and bear fruit to accompany the men and women of your country to the Lord. **He, with His presence among us, revives hope and renews life.

I entrust you to the maternal intercession of Mary Immaculate, Patroness of the United States of America, and I assure you of my prayers for you, for your families, and for your local communities. I impart my Blessing to you all.

One way to give thanks to God for all the gifts He has bestowed on you is to work for the poor and vulnerable. Sharing your gifts with those less fortunate is how God intends you to use what He gives you. *"Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more"* (Luke 12:48).

Say, "Amen!"

The proper form when receiving Communion is to reply "Amen" when the Eucharistic minister raises the Host or Chalice and pronounces it, "The Body (or Blood) of Christ." By responding this way, you openly state your belief in the presence of Christ in the Eucharistic bread and wine, as well as in His Body, the Church.

Respond to the gift of the Holy Spirit

God loves us so much, He gives us what He values most – His only Son (John 3:16) and His Holy Spirit in Baptism (Romans 5:5) so we can have access to God's divine life and love. The Holy Spirit's presence with the entire Church throughout the centuries is as a comfort, consolation, leader and guide. To accept this gift, we can ...

Listen for Him: Spending time with Scripture can help tune our hearts to hear the *"still small voice"* (1 Kings 19:12) of the Holy Spirit. The better we are attuned to God's voice, the more likely we'll hear Him amidst the noise of the world.
Consult Him: Jesus promised to send

the Holy Spirit, the Counselor, to lead His disciples to truth (John 14:6). He helps us to see, evaluate, and choose like Christ. Call on the Holy Spirit when you're facing a difficult situation or decision.

Take refuge in Him: Every day, entrust yourself to the Holy Spirit and dedicate your day to His service. Let Him guide your actions.

Actualize Confirmation graces: Upon our Confirmation, the Holy Spirit fortified and empowered our souls with His seven Gifts: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord (Isaiah 11:2). When we rely on the Holy Spirit, we can overcome temptations to fear, distrust, and selfishness with His powerful gifts.

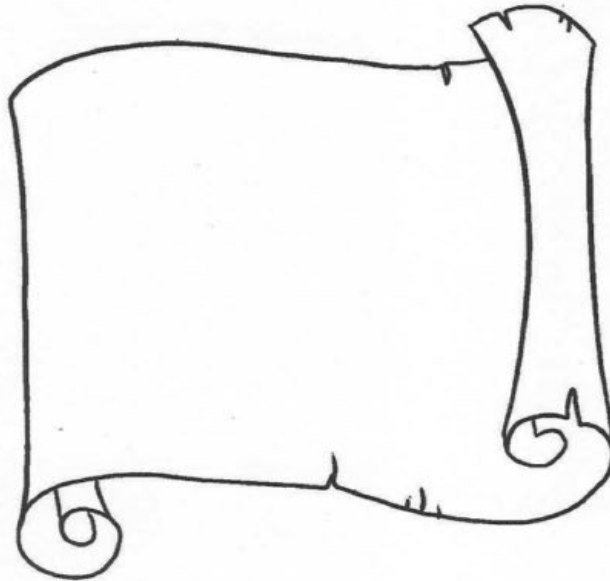

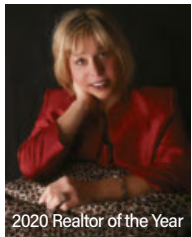
