

Welcome to CHRIST THE KING Sunday, which is the last Sunday of our liturgical year, celebrating the salvation Jesus Christ has won for us, and the eternal kingdom he has prepared for those who follow him. With endings come new beginnings — another chance for people to wake to the invitation and challenge of obedience and loyalty expected of us. We celebrate the victory of Jesus Christ our Savior, our King. He has defeated death, and opened the way to heaven for us. We should renew our loyalty, focus on our duties, and look forward to sharing in his eternal life.

Happily, later this week we expect Father John Kallattil to be back with us after his visit to his family and friends in India. Our usual weekday schedule of Masses—8:30am Monday to Saturday, and 12 Noon Masses Tuesdays to Fridays—resumes this Friday, December 1. This is a First Friday of the month, and we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament following the Noon Mass. This quiet time of prayer concludes with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament just before 3pm.

Our annual preparations for the Holy Name Society's popular CHRISTMAS TREE REMEMBRANCE on our property at Slosson and Victory begins this weekend with delivery of our trees. That will be followed next week with the Christmas lights adorning them, and then the following Saturday evening after the 4pm Mass, we have our beautiful Lighting of Christmas Trees ceremony after the 4pm Mass. That will be on December 9. Thank you to all who have already reserved a tree.

I am already receiving many appeals in the mail for Christmas giving. I will guess that you are too. So this next month is a time to decide about your Christmas giving to family and friends, and I hope, to our church. Jesus Christ our King allows us to partner with Him in spreading the Good News of salvation in our own homes and neighborhood. And your Church must do this for people in a world burdened by false hopes and bitter fights. Your Christmas gift to our Church will be very much appreciated, and will help us to spread the Good News about Jesus our Savior.

I would like to tell you about an article written by a Protestant minister about a Jewish rabbi in a magazine for Catholic priests. The magazine is THE PRIEST. I wrote a monthly column in THE PRIEST for ten years. Reverend Victor Parachin's article must have been better than mine that month, because I saved it. I found it recently, and want to share it with you.

The minister's article was about Jewish people and their great commitment to sharing resources and taking care of others. He wrote about a revered rabbi—Moses Maimonides—and his imagination of a GOLDEN LADDER OF CHARITY.

Rabbi Moses Maimonides (1135-1204) was a famous rabbi, philosopher, physician, and astronomer. On the subject of helping one another, he described eight levels of giving. This may be helpful to us to understand our own assumptions and choices as we all receive many appeals for worthy causes, and have to decide on suitable responses.

Rabbi Maimonides was quoted in that article by Lutheran pastor Reverend Victor Parachin in January 2016 about various styles for helping others. First you will find Reverend Parachin's Christian overview useful:

"Scripture is clear and consistent in its call to people of faith to respond generously and unhesitatingly when a need presents itself...

- Give to another as the Lord your God has blessed you
- Freely have you received; freely give to others
- · We have different gifts, given to be used for the common good
- · It is more blessed to give than to receive

Our opportunities to give are numerous, and so are the ways we can respond. Some people, learning of a need, open their heart, hand, and checkbook. Others may give grudgingly, or not at all. The Bible commends the first ones, teaching in Saint Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians, chapter 9, verse 7, that God loves a cheerful giver."


Rabbi Maimonides' GOLDEN LADDER OF CHARITY was built on eight levels of giving. His Steps 4, 5, and 6 are details about how/whether to let the giver be known, lest the recipient be embarrassed. With limited space here, I offer for your consideration this great Rabbi's most important steps on THE GOLDEN LADDER OF CHARITY:

- 1. To give, but with reluctance or regret.
- 2. To give cheerfully, but not with proportion to the distress of the suffering.
- 3. To give cheerfully, and proportionately, but not until we are solicited.
- 7. To bestow charity in such a way that the benefactor does not know the relieved persons, nor the relieved persons know the name of their benefactor.
- 8. The highest and most meritorious level of giving is to anticipate charity by relieving poverty: to assist the reduced brother either by a considerable gift, or a loan of money, or by putting him in the way of business, so that he may earn an honest livelihood and not be forced into the dreadful alternative of holding up his hand for charity.




