February 3rd is the annual feastday of Saint Blaise, a bishop and martyr of the 4th century. Tradition says that he saved a boy from choking on a fish bone which was caught in his throat. You know that it is a popular custom for people of faith to ask for the help of specific saints for specific problems. For example: Saint Anthony when we have lost something, Saint Rita for family problems, Saint Lucy when we have trouble with our eyes.

And since Saint Blaise is credited with helping a boy who was choking - and none of us wants to choke or have a sore throat or anything to go wrong with our swallowing - we will include a special blessing at all the Masses on this Saturday and Sunday, at the conclusion of the Prayer of the Faithful, for the help of Saint Blaise. This is the prayer: THROUGH THE INTERCESSION OF SAINT BLAISE, BISHOP AND MARTYR, MAY GOD DELIVER YOU FROM EVERY DISEASE OF THE THROAT, AND FROM EVERY OTHER ILLNESS, IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. To which we will all say Amen. (And if you wish, you can have a prayer with blessed candles placed on your throat at the end of the Mass after others leave.)

Another kind of sickness with worse results comes from our sins. Jesus is the best one to help remedy our sins and temptations. And Lent is the best season for self-improvement and for helping others. **ASH WEDNESDAY IS FEBRUARY 14.** Take charge of your spiritual life and improve your daily living by using the proven remedies for lethargy and weakness. Increase your **PRAYING, FASTING, AND ALMSGIVING.** (About this word **almsgiving**: look at the colorful announcement on page 5 about the **CARDINAL'S ANNUAL STEWARDSHIP APPEAL**. This is a very effective and important charity that deliberately coincides with the season of Lent. As usual, I count on you to help us again in this form of **almsgiving**. And I thank you in advance for your generosity.)

As for prayer: on Ash Wednesday, receive ashes in a Catholic Church, preferably while attending a Mass and staying for Holy Communion. The ashes of burnt palms are traced on your forehead in the shape of the Cross. If you have any palm branches in your home, bring them to the rear of our church by 11am on February 11. Our Boy Scouts will serve us by burning all those palms and reducing them to ashes which we then use on Ash Wednesday.

ASH WEDNESDAY IS FEBRUARY 14. It is one of the most important days of the year for repenting our sins, promising God to improve, and dealing with the fact that we are dust, and to dust we will return. What are your local Mass choices? (Some people go to get ashes near where they work.) Ashes will be traced on our foreheads during Mass after the Gospel, and after Mass. We have Masses Wednesday February 14 at 8:30am, 12 Noon, and 7:30pm. We also have a Mass just for our elementary school students. And we have an Afternoon Service open to everyone at 3:30. This is especially convenient for parents and children coming from schools. I will stay in church to give ashes until 4:30pm. Even big days are easy to forget, so just in case, make a mental note: ASH WEDNESDAY IS FEBRUARY 14! I AM GOING TO MAKE A GOOD START TO LENT THAT DAY!

But how will you do that? What are the tried-and-true ingredients for a success-filled Lent? What are the ways to prove you are in control of your desires, and ready and willing to make sacrifices to offset your weaknesses and your sins? Giving up leisure and pleasures, giving away money, contributing your time to help others, coming to Masses during the week besides on Sundays: you get the idea. There are even official rules for what not to eat. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting (less food, smaller meals) and abstinence from eating meat. This is obligatory, depending on health, for all Catholics ages 18 to 59, but people of other ages can do this too. And all the Fridays of Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from eating meat.


