

If you have been coming to Mass and reading our bulletin, you know **you have a big priority this Wednesday**. All Christians, especially Catholic Christians, should begin a valuable penitential period of forty days—forty like the years in the desert for our wandering Jewish ancestors after escaping from slavery in Egypt; forty like the number of days Jesus spent fasting in the desert as he began his public ministry — forty days from this **ASH WEDNESDAY** to the beginning of the sacred events of Holy Thursday supper, Good Friday crucifixion, Holy Saturday, **EASTER SUNDAY**!

Plan your Wednesday and do all you can to come to Mass and have a priest impose ashes on your forehead in the sign of the Cross and say to you **REMEMBER THAT YOU ARE DUST, AND TO DUST YOU SHALL RETURN**. We will distribute ashes after the Gospel and homily at <u>Masses at 8:30, 12 Noon, 7:30pm</u>—and at the end of the Mass. Also we have a School Mass just for St. Teresa-St. Rita students. We also have a special <u>Liturgy of the Word at 3:30</u> for children and families coming from public schools, and I will stay in church until 4:30. Come to a Mass or one of these services if you can; make a good start to Lent, so you will have a holy Easter and a wonderful life after death.

SALUTE is the name of an inspiring and informative magazine published by the **Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA**. It goes to many people in and out of the military, who contribute their prayers and their money to help support the expenses of the military Archdiocese, which does not receive government funding as it does its crucial spiritual and pastoral work for the Catholic members of our Armed Forces throughout our country and the whole world.

In the Fall 2023 issue of **SALUTE** there was an article about a Mass celebrated on 5 September 2023 for the repose of the soul of Father Vincent Capodanno, M.M. He was a priest of the Maryknoll Missionary order. During the Vietnam War he volunteered to become a Navy Chaplain, assigned to Marines. Killed on a battlefield in Vietnam on September 4, 1967, Father Capodanno was posthumously awarded our Nation's highest military decoration: the Medal of Honor. There is also hope that our Catholic Church will one day officially declare Father Vincent Capodanno to be a Saint.

Father Capodanno grew up on Staten Island. Capodanno Boulevard in South Beach is named for him. His grave is near us in Saint Peter's Cemetery. I placed a copy of his portrait in our vestibule several years ago. Many of us hope that one day his life of service—and his sacrificial death while ministering to wounded soldiers on a field of battle—will lead to his being named a Saint. Already he is officially recognized by our Church with the title "Servant of God." If you would like to know more about him, here is an email address you can write to: www.capodannoguild.org.

An award-winning film has been made and is broadcast often on EWTN—the Eternal Word Television Network—around the day of his death. It is titled *Called and Chosen—Father Vincent R. Capodanno*. You can have a DVD of that film by making a small donation to the Capodanno Guild.

You can also subscribe to **SALUTE** (at PO Box 4469, Washington DC 20077-5203). This recent article had more details about the chaplain's death in combat while rushing to the aid of ambushed Marines in Vietnam's Que Son Valley. Archbishop Timothy Broglio, the Archbishop for the Military Archdiocese, celebrated that Mass in the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. He is the official promoter for the Cause of Canonization for Father Capodanno.

In his homily, Archbishop Broglio—who is also the elected Chairman of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, so a very busy and impressive man—quoted a letter he had received from a Marine who served with Father Capodanno. That soldier was very happy that Father Vincent was there on the battlefield when soldiers needed him.

This led the Archbishop to an appeal for more vocations to priesthood, and for more men willing and able to become chaplains. They are needed forthwith: "As Father Capodanno offered absolution from sin, or the healing of the anointing of the sick, or celebrated Mass for his Marines, Father knew that no one other than a priest could provide those precious gifts." And a Marine at the Mass, Bob Pinkerton, recalled Fr. Capodanno as a true apostle: "Fr.Capodanno did not like being in the rear. He wanted to be with his Marines. To help the medics and the corpsmen. He wanted to be there to give last rites. And he wanted to be there to see who he could save if possible. And he put his life on the line for that."




