

Our Parish was happy to host the annual Mass to honor and pray with Consecrated Religious [that is, the Sisters and Brothers in religious congregations] who live or work on Staten Island. This happened at our 12:30 Mass on Sunday February 18. Bishop Peter Byrne, our Episcopal Vicar and the pastor of Blessed Sacrament Church, came to celebrate the Mass. The men of our Holy Name Society sponsored and served at a reception for our guests after Mass in the lower church hall. Holy Name men who were able to present included Brian Laub, Pete Turner, John Bouma, Al Peteroy, Chris Rendinaro, Rich Newman, and Bob Mazzarella.

Father John and I were happy to attend the CONCERT FOR PEACE that was held on February 21 at Saint Joseph-By-The-Sea High School. The fighting in Israel is taking a very heavy toll on everyone's minds and bodies. This concert's purpose was to pray for peace in Israel and raise awareness on SI of the important work being done by CNEWA—the Catholic New East Welfare Association. CNEWA is a Papal ministry started more than a hundred years ago to assist struggling Christians living in the Holy Land and other locations. Donations to CNEWA really get to people in need. More than four hundred people attended the PEACE concert, and more than \$8,400 was raised that night. Our Saint Teresa-Saint Rita STREAM Academy was one of the Staten Island Catholic schools that participated. Each school had a CNEWA country to speak about and show slides, and a popular song to sing. It was enlightening and inspiring. There was even a bonus that I did not realize—how behind the scenes, all the singers from all the schools joined one another. Here is part of a letter that one Principal sent to all the schools the next day:

"I was going back and forth between the auditorium and the auxiliary gym where the singers were waiting. Toward the end of the night, I was in the gym. Our students were lined up to go back into the auditorium for everyone to sing God Bless America when we saw seven or eight girls from St. Teresa's chanting and dancing in a circle. Another school joined, then another. One of our students was inching closer and closer. I saw she wanted to join and I encouraged her but she was afraid. A mom from St. Teresa's saw our interaction and she came and got her. With that, a large majority of our girls joined, and then more schools. What started as one school in a circle with a 5-foot diameter turned into ten schools with a 50-foot diameter. It was heart-warming."

Also heart-warming has been happy experiences and new friendships for those who took advantage of one or both of our St. Teresa Parish Pilgrimages in recent years. Mrs. Macrina Reyes has been Coordinator, supported by her husband Deacon Jonathan Reyes, with myself as Spiritual Director. We went to the Holy Land in 2021, and to Italy in 2023. After much planning, today we are announcing our next destination, and sufficient lead time—thirteen months—to plan, reserve a space, and save for an <u>APRIL 2025 Pilgrimage</u> to great sights and sacred spaces of FRANCE—the native land of The Little Flower, our Parish Patron, Saint Teresa of Lisieux.

In recent weeks I have been quoting parts of a new document written by Pope Francis about our patron saint. He reminds us of Saint Teresa's continuing impact as one of the greatest saints of modern times. The more we know about her, the greater our devotion and benefit. May 1925 was when she was officially declared a Saint—and in March 1926 Cardinal Patrick Hayes signed the papers incorporating a new parish on Victory Blvd. in Staten Island, and spelling her name without an h. And so the Reyes and I hope you will agree that the timing is right for us to make a pilgrimage to our Saint's hometown—and to also visit the beaches of Normandy and cemeteries of brave soldiers who died on D-Day; the great Cathedral of Chartres; many sacred spaces, sights, sounds, and great food of Paris; and to end our pilgrimage with prayers at the awesome shrine where the Mother of God is known to have appeared to Saint Bernadette—and is loved by all as Our Lady of Lourdes.

The dates for our travel are April 21-28, 2025. We leave on the Monday after Easter (April 21) and return a week later, in the afternoon of April 28. Estimated cost, to be finalized in June—depending on changes in airfare, departure taxes and fuel surcharges—is \$3,795 each, sharing a room. We will use one bus, so seats are limited. We will soon receive a handsome enrollment brochure with all details for those who are interested. This pilgrimages will be skillfully conducted by the Peter's Way company that we have used before and have organized pilgrimages for many groups.

April in Paris! Didn't someone write a song about that? It certainly is something to look forward to.






