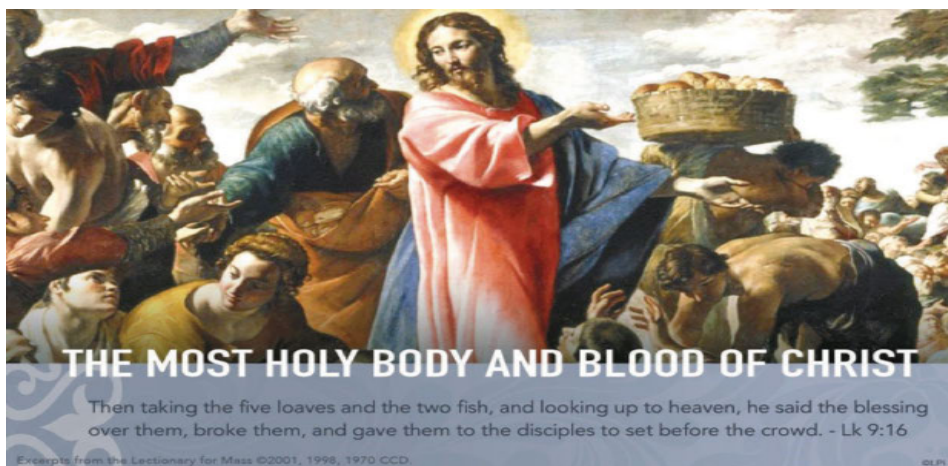

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

God has called each of us to be part of His family of faith—the Catholic Church—and then He gives some individuals special invitations for their own particular vocations in life. Marriage is a vocation, and so is Holy Orders. People getting married in church make a permanent, exclusive commitment to each other to share their life and love, and we call this the Sacrament of Marriage.

Similarly, a man who is called by God to Holy Orders — deacon, priest, or bishop — also makes a lifelong commitment to serve others, and to do so as directed by his bishop or religious superior. In fact, these two Sacraments—Marriage and Holy Orders—are explained together in the official teaching called Catechism of the Catholic Church. They are called: Sacraments at the Service of the Church.

If you or your family do not have a copy of the Catechism of the Catholic Church and this summer would like to learn more about what Catholics believe and live by, and what possibilities exist for our greater happiness and faith, ask me for a copy, or send for your own. Besides a Bible, this might be the best thing you ever get from Amazon.

Another invitation that you might pray about, and a person that you might help, is someone you know in your parish or family or circle of friends or co-workers, who is a good man who God might be calling to become a priest.

We have spoken about this and placed cards in the pews with the title CALLED BY NAME. CALLED BY NAME is a new initiative that Cardinal Dolan has begun to honor faithful young men in our archdiocese who love Christ and the Church. He wants to invite them to consider whether they are interested in exploring a vocation to the priesthood.

And His Eminence is asking people like us to honor people we think might become effective ordained priests, so that there may be sufficient priests for the next generations who also will need to hear the Gospel preached, with Masses and sacraments celebrated, and parishes with many activities available to them. The Cardinal will send an invitation for them to meet him for special events, and a Vocation Team to give them support and encouragement.

CALLED BY NAME began just a few weeks ago and is having positive results. See the information/reply form on page 4, and return it to me or to Cardinal Dolan, 488 Madison Av. 3rd floor, NY 10022. You can see something in someone that opens unexpected possibilities. We are all responsible for encouraging one another—especially our youth—to believe in themselves, and to reach for their best future. To quote the words of God in Isaiah the Prophet, chapter 43, verse 1: *“Do not be afraid, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name and you are mine.”*

Two believers and role models for young people who want to serve God are soon to be Saints: Pier Giorgio Frassati, and Carlo Acutis. They will be canonized together at the Vatican in Rome on Sunday September 7th.

Originally, their canonizations had been scheduled separately: Acutis on Divine Mercy Sunday April 27, as part of the Jubilee of Adolescents; and Frassati during the Youth Day in late July. However, both were postponed after the passing of Pope Francis on April 21. Their joint canonization has now been set for Sunday, September 7, 2025.

Carlo Acutis was a 15-year-old Italian tech-savvy teenager who created a website cataloging Eucharistic miracles before he died in 2006, and was beatified in Assisi in 2020. He has quickly become an icon of “ordinary sanctity” by fusing deep devotion with contemporary life. Pier Giorgio Frassati, who died at age 24 in 1925, was known for his vibrant faith, his social activism, and his service for and love of the poor. For decades he has been the quiet patron of students and young Catholics seeking meaning beyond materialism.

Their now unified canonization in September offers a powerful symbol: two youthful saints celebrated together, bridging the digital age and early 20th-century witness. Since many people had planned to come in April for Carlo Acutis’ canonization, it will likely draw vast crowds to Rome especially in the vibrant context of this Jubilee Year.

Let us pray to these new saints to help more young men in the Archdiocese of New York to take a fresh look at their choices for a happy and meaningful life, and for service and satisfaction, by becoming Catholic priests.

## PHYSICIANS AGAINST ASSISTED SUICIDE

At its annual meeting, **American Medical Association (AMA) House of Delegates (HOD)** overwhelmingly rejected an attempt to change AMA policy and in doing so **re-affirmed its longstanding policy in opposition to assisted suicide.**

It also approved a Board of Trustees report which rejected attempts to change the longstanding and clear terminology "physician assisted suicide" in AMA policy. Dating to 1994, the AMA Code of Medical Ethics states that "Physician-assisted suicide is fundamentally incompatible with the physician's role as healer, would be difficult or impossible to control, and would pose serious societal risks."

At its 2019 annual meeting, the House of Delegates overwhelmingly voted to uphold the Code of Medical Ethics as written. The 2025 Board of Trustees report states that "the profession of medicine should not support the legalization or practice of physician assisted suicide or see it as part of a physician's role."

A proposed change in terminology to "medical aid in dying" was rejected. The Board of Trustees noted that, "Descriptors such as Medical Aid in Dying (MAID), physician aid-in-dying, and death with dignity could apply to palliative care practices and compassionate care near the end of life that do not include intending the death of patients... this degree of ambiguity is unacceptable for providing ethical guidance." The House of Delegates, comprised of representatives from state medical associations, national medical specialty societies, AMA sections, and other professional interest medical associations, is the principal legislative and policy-making body of the AMA.

"In 2016, the AMA initiated a three-year study of physician-assisted suicide which culminated in the AMA House of Delegates re-affirming the AMA Code of Medical Ethics in 2019," stated Dr. Jeff White, Patients' Rights Action Fund board member and a former AMA House of Delegates member. "Nothing has changed in the ensuing years to warrant a change in AMA policy and terminology. We are extremely pleased with the results of the AMA House of Delegates vote and its recognition that physicians are trained to heal and must not perform euthanasia or participate in assisted suicide."
