

NEXT SUNDAY'S SCHEDULE OF MASSES FOR PRIESTS

On this last day of August, with many of us focusing on the start of school, let me ask for prayers for all our parishioners who are students and/or teachers, so that these coming days of learning and teaching will be blessed by God our Father and assisted by the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Beginning and ending each day with prayers together is a hallmark of Catholic schools like our own **SAINT TERESA—SAINT RITA STREAM ACADEMY.** Mrs. Nicole C. Fresca is beginning her sixth year as our principal and has sixteen years of experience as a principal. This Thursday September 4 will be the first day of school for all grades.

Our Catholic school is flourishing, as we serve more than three hundred students in grades K-3 to 8. This past June, we had 29 well-prepared graduates, all of whom made the Catholic High School that was their first choice. Their high school tuition scholarship offers exceeded \$170,000. Our popular and successful Religious Education Program is led by Mrs. Lisa Rametta. This will be her eleventh year as our Religious Education Director. More than 250 students are enrolled in our Tuesday 4pm-5:30 religious education program. We started with virtual teaching even during Covid, and our teachers adjusted and are very good at it. Our parents were polled as Covid ended, and a big majority said this was helpful and effective, and asked us to keep virtual instruction.

Every child is visible on a screen to the teacher and to Mrs. Rametta. We see many adults in the home listening and also learning with their children. Additional volunteers to teach, substitute, or be helpful are invited to speak with Mrs. Rametta.

And because every one of our young parishioners needs a religious education and experience coming to Sunday Mass, and must be enrolled for years before receiving First Holy Communion or Confirmation, please be sure to act now if you haven't done so already. If you are not registered yet, please call the CCD office 718 981 2632, so your child can have his/her books. The first day for our Religious Education Classes will be Tuesday September 16.

While you are marking your September calendars, let me ask you to plan to join us next Sunday September 7 after Mass at our parish's beautiful dignified **9/11 MEMORIAL**. For a few moments after each Mass, we say a prayer, remember the loss, and read the names of ten of our parishioners who died at the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001. For those who pause with us, it is a meaningful moment of prayer and reflection.

I also invite you to come at 7:30pm on Wednesday September 10 to Our Lady of Pity Church, 1616 Richmond Avenue, for a special annual event held on the night before the day of the tragedy. This September 10th will be the 23rd annual **SOLEMN REMEMBRANCE OF THE EVENTS OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2001**. Sacred music begins at 7pm. Mass begins at 7:30 with Bishop Peter Byrne as celebrant, Bishop John O'Hara as homilist, with other clergy present. At the end of the Mass, we have a powerful ceremony: reading aloud the names of all Staten Islanders who died on September 11. This memorial Mass is sponsored by the University of Notre Dame Alumni Club of Staten Island.

Our own religious education should be a lifelong process. What we learn as children in religion class is just the beginning of knowing the people and the stories in the Bible. All of us should know our Bible. Not just what shelf it is on, covered with dust, but on which table nearby, ready for you to pick it up and read. Last Sunday I cited an **ESSENTIAL GUIDE TO THE HOLY BIBLE** (available from Catholic Bishops Conference *usccbpublishing.org*) and quoted some facts about Jesus and His mother Mary. Today we will focus on several more great people in salvation history:

Joseph is the foster-father of Jesus and the husband of Mary. He is the head of the Holy Family. One of Joseph's ancestors was King David, which links Jesus to his role as the Messiah and King. Joseph, no king himself but a very good man, is enlightened by an angel about the supernatural nature of Mary's pregnancy (Mt.1:18-25). He does not divorce her, but trusts what she says, and brings her with him to Bethlehem, to be counted in a census. He is there at the birth of the Redeemer in Bethlehem, and at the presentation of the baby in the Temple. After the flight into Egypt, he establishes their home in Nazareth, where he works as a carpenter and teaches Jesus how to do this manual labor.

John the Baptist is a cousin of Jesus, six months older, born to the elderly couple Zechariah and Elizabeth. In the womb of Elizabeth, John leaps for joy when Mary and Jesus approach them. Decades later, John the Baptist lived a radical life in the desert, preaching about the need to repent of sins and be baptized in water. He eats locusts and wild honey (see Mk 1:2-15). John protests when Jesus comes to him for a baptism at the beginning of his public ministry, but gives in. John condemns the adultery of the powerful Herod Antipas, who is attracted by John's words. But Herod also makes a drunken promise, and at the behest of his lover Herodias, he has John the Baptist beheaded.




