Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

Please join us tomorrow—Monday December 8—as we celebrate the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a holyday of obligation for all who can come. We have Masses at 8:30am, 12 Noon, 7:30pm. And say this prayer: **O MARY CONCEIVED WITHOUT SIN, PRAY FOR US WHO HAVE RECOURSE TO THEE.**

Fifty beautiful high quality Christmas trees have arrived and been placed by the great men of our parish's HOLY NAME SOCIETY. Next Saturday evening December 13, after the 4pm Mass, we will have our Tree Lighting ceremony with white lights, donor's name placards, and family decorations. Everyone is invited to this festive ceremony and for our famous hot cocoa. Our thanks to all who donated two hundred dollars for a tree.

This Christmas display is a sign of our faith, and something that can lift people's spirits as they go by our strategic corner at Victory and Slosson. Our annual Christmas display of faith and family helps ourselves and our neighbors to think about Christ Mass Day, and prepare to welcome Jesus and make this a holy season.

This has already been a busy time of the year. We had good attendance for Mass on Thanksgiving at 9am. I shared some geographical reasons for us to thank God for what our country has, but may take for granted.

I have been reading a very interesting book called **PRISONERS OF GEOGRAPHY**. Subtitle is: **TEN MAPS THAT EXPLAIN EVERYTHING ABOUT THE WORLD**. The publisher is Scribner; the author is Tim Marshall, a reporter with thirty years experience in more than forty countries. A review from Newsweek magazine says: "Shows how geography shapes not just history but destiny."

The publisher's cover notes addresses geopolitics: *"All leaders of nations are constrained by geography. Their choices are limited by mountains, rivers, seas, and concrete. In this book the author examines Russia, China, the United States, Latin America, the Middle East, Africa, Western Europe, India and Pakistan, Korea and Japan, Latin America, even Greenland and the Arctic—their climates, seas, mountains, rivers, deserts and borders—to provide a context often missing from political reportage."*

In ten up-to-date maps Marshall explains the geopolitical strategies of these key parts of the globe, and answers questions like: *Why will America never be invaded? Why must Russia have a navy even with ports frozen six months a year? How is China's future curbed by its geography? Why will Europe never be united?*

The chapter on the United States says that if you won the lottery and wanted to buy a country, the first one your real state agent would show you would be the United States of America. And then he presents totally persuasive reasons why, including the history of events such as the defeat of the British in our Revolutionary War, the Louisiana Purchase in 1803 that doubled the size of the United States, and gave us New Orleans and mastery of the greatest inland water transport route in the entire world. And then about the Transcontinental Treaty of 1819 with Spain that gave us Florida—and a definite boundary line all the way to the Pacific Ocean.

No matter where people live, it is very appropriate for this season to read **DILEXI TE**—the first document of the papacy of Pope Leo XIV. He issues a call to all Christians to reinforce our commitment to walk in the footsteps of Christ. Jesus took on the poverty of everyone's human condition—no matter where or when we live. To follow Him, we should walk in the footsteps of countless men and women throughout the history of the Church who have expressed their love for God through generosity and service to their neighbors: by caring for the sick, by educating, by healing, by clothing, by accompanying those who are least among us.

In his letter the Pope reminds all Christians, "The same Jesus who tells us, 'The poor you will always have with you' (Mt 26:11), also promises the disciples: 'I am with you always' (Mt 28:20). Likewise, he says: 'Just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me' (Mt 25:40). This is not a matter of mere human kindness but a revelation: contact with those who are lowly and powerless is a fundamental way of encountering the Lord of history. In the poor, Jesus continues to speak to us" (*Dilexi Te*, 5).

*Dilexi Te* is an eloquent reminder that no matter where we live, our love for God and our deepest convictions need to be expressed in action. Your donations to our Church at Christmas helps us to "break down barriers, bring close those who were distant, unite strangers, reconcile enemies. Love for Jesus and one another spans chasms that are humanly impossible to bridge" (*Dilexi Te*, 120).

### **PRAY and ASK FOR GOVERNOR'S VETO**

**The New York Alliance Against Assisted Suicide (NYAAAS)** is asking us to keep on peacefully and respectfully urging Gov. Kathy Hochul to veto Bill S.138-Hoylman-Sigal/A.136-Paulin, the assisted suicide bill, if you share our Catholic Church's strong opposition to this dangerous legislation.

As many New Yorkers know, the assisted suicide bill passed both houses of the New York State Legislature earlier this year despite strong, principled bipartisan opposition. Now, the battle against assisted suicide has shifted to the Governor's office. At this writing, the assisted suicide bill has not yet been forwarded to Gov. Hochul for consideration. To the best of our knowledge, it appears that the Governor has not yet made up her mind on this issue.

Advocates of doctor-assisted death have been doing their best to draw attention to their destructive bill and to pressure Gov. Hochul to sign it. It is important for the Governor and her staff to see and hear from New Yorkers who strongly oppose assisted suicide.


