Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Parish,

Grace and peace with you on this First Sunday of Advent, the start of a new year of Masses and graces to help us to be peaceful and going in the right direction: towards knowing and loving God, towards living a peaceful satisfying life, towards forgiveness of sins and a welcome into the company of saints in heaven. Starting today we have three and a half weeks to prepare ourselves to celebrate the Birth of Jesus—the Son of God and the Savior of the world. Prepare to greet Him by Masses each Sunday during Advent. And keep in mind that **JESUS IS THE REASON FOR THIS SEASON.**

I am happy to say that we expect to see Father John Kallattil back with us today! His visit to his religious order and his family in India has gone well. With Father John's return, this Tuesday we will resume our usual practice of weekday Masses: 8:30 Mondays to Saturdays, and 12 Noon every Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Speaking of special schedules, let me announce the Mass schedule for Monday December 8—the holyday of obligation that helps us celebrate the **IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**. Mary was conceived without sin so that she would be uniquely worthy to be the mother of Jesus. And because Mary is the Patron Saint of the United States of America, this is holyday of obligation for everyone who can come to Mass on that day.

To begin with, next week on December 7 readings and prayers at our 5:00 Sunday night Mass will be of Sunday, the Second Sunday of Advent. **Our Masses for the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be as follows:** Monday 8:30am, 12 Noon, afternoon Mass just for our St. Teresa-St. Rita Academy students, and a last Mass at 7:30pm.

For those who have been wanting to request a Mass intention for a deceased loved one, perhaps on a birthday or an anniversary of death, the Mass Book for January to June is now open for reservations. If you are not familiar with this kind practice, or want more information, please call us at 718 442 5412. Your presence at those Masses offered for the repose of souls can be a benefit for the people who have died and a devout and consoling connection for the living.

This is also a chance to remind you that we offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation every Saturday from 12 noon to 1pm. We have two private confessionals in the rear of the church. **Making a confession is an excellent way to prepare for Christmas and for the worthy reception of Holy Communion.** Besides all Saturdays from 12 to 1, there will be another opportunity for confessions on **RECONCILIATION MONDAY** – Monday December 19, between 2-4, and 6-8.

Advent is a season in two parts. Knowing that we are sinners and will be judged by God for what we have done and what we have failed to do, Advent pays attention to the end of time and of the world as we know it. Coinciding with the appearance in glory of our Risen Lord Jesus Christ will be God's final judgment of the living and the dead.

**So these first days of Advent** remind us of the end of the world, the glorious Second Coming of our Lord Jesus, and the importance of being ready for judgment by God that happens to everyone when we die. **During the second half of Advent** the prayers and readings at Mass change focus to telling the story of the first coming of Jesus the Messiah, relating the experiences of Mary and Joseph, who were chosen by God the Father to form a Holy Family with Jesus. He was born, both human and divine, in Bethlehem, because of God the Father's love for the human race. He gave us a new Adam and a second chance to be the united and devoted people He wants us to be. Jesus came on a mission: to educate, encourage, and empower people to be baptized and be part of His One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic CHURCH. **CHRIST MASS DAY** is when we celebrate the appearance of that wonderful gift from God.

For those who want to plan ahead: Christmas Eve Masses will be on December 24 at 4pm in St. Teresa Church and also at 4pm in St. Nicholas Chapel. There will be a Christmas Eve Mass at 9pm in our church with Choir Concert before. Then on Christmas Day: Masses will be at 7:30am in Church, 9am in St. Nicholas Chapel, 10:30am in Church, and 12:30pm in Church. Those are the Masses we will have on Christmas Day. FYI—for people who want to go later on Christmas Day itself, Saint Christopher Parish in Grant City plans to have a Mass at 6pm.
