

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

I would like to remind you about a wonderful good deed of our parish and our parishioners, and then reveal a secret about the clever use of a popular Christmas Carol that also taught young Catholics details of their Catholic Faith.

On the Sunday after Christmas I went to the annual Christmas holiday party hosted by our neighbors, the residents on Windsor Road who live in ARCHCARE AT SAINT TERESA. This was once a convent for the Sisters teaching in our school. Our parish built that in 1960 for the great Presentation Sisters of the Blessed Virgin Mary. These PBVM Sisters started and ran our parish school for many years. The last Sisters to live here moved to their Motherhouse around 2013. Then we hosted temporary residents sponsored by Salem Church—generous volunteers who came from other states to help Staten Islanders after Hurricane Sandy. The convent was empty then for awhile, until it became the perfect place for a completely new initiative in New York State: a residence for young autistic adults who were living at home with their parents—who were very worried about what would happen to their adult children once they were gone.

Credit Cardinal Timothy Dolan for paying attention to these parental concerns, and asking ARCHCARE, the health care ministry of the Archdiocese of New York, which now includes Carmel Richmond Healthcare and Eger Healthcare, to find a way to respond to that need, though others had failed. It took a lot of study, information for our neighbors, public meetings, fundraising, and new construction. But eventually our 1960 building was totally gutted, redesigned and rebuilt by ARCHCARE. It is now called ARCHCARE AT SAINT TERESA. For the last five years it has been the happy peaceful home of eight young autistic adults, one person who is not autistic, and a site manager from ARCHCARE.

So to me this year's Christmas holiday party was kind of an anniversary, because it was six years ago, in January 2020 – that residents began to move into their new home and to develop their independence and friendships. This has been a great success. Each person has an apartment and a lease, and pays rent which provides income for our church. There is independence but also community, and families are nearby. All are Staten Islanders; two are members of our parish. Everyone likes being there, and none of our original residents have moved out.

The night of the party, I was a guest, along with their parents and siblings. People talked, ate, watched videos, played games, and sang songs. That included a classic holiday carol called THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS.

Besides being a festive tune that began in England in the 18<sup>th</sup> century and appeals to children, THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS gives many people a chance to take parts and have fun as they sing together.

But songs can carry a secret meaning. That is useful, because Catholics in England, from 1558 to 1829, were not permitted to openly practice their faith or to teach their religion to their children. Brave priests did smuggle themselves into the country to offer Masses in private homes, and parents did secretly teach their Catholic religious beliefs to their children. But many priests were discovered, imprisoned, and killed, and Catholic families had to be very careful.

So after singing THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS at the party, it was of interest to me to read an article in the Brooklyn TABLET – the Catholic newspaper of the Brooklyn diocese – that said that some Catholics made a religious connection to each of the twelve days between Christmas and Epiphany.

- \* **A Partridge in a Pear Tree**      **Represents Jesus Christ, the true gift of Christmas**
- \* **Two Turtle Doves**              **Symbolize the Old Testament and the New Testament**
- \* **Three French Hens**              **The three great theological virtues: Faith, Hope, Charity**
- \* **Four Calling Birds**              **The Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, John**
  
- \* **Five Golden Rings**              **First books of Bible (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy)**
  
- \* **Six Geese a-Laying**              **The six days of creation described in the Bible Book of Genesis**
- \* **Seven Swans a-Swimming**      **The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit (Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, Fear of the Lord)**
- \* **Eight Maids a-Milking**          **The eight beatitudes given by Jesus in his Sermon on the Mount (Blessed are the poor in spirit... the merciful...the peacemakers, etc)**
- \* **Nine Ladies Dancing**          **Represents the nine Fruits (good results) of the Holy Spirit: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Modesty, Faithfulness, Self-Control**
- \* **Ten Lords a-Leaping**          **The Ten Commandments that were given to Moses**
- \* **Eleven Pipers Piping**          **The Eleven Faithful Apostles (Judas betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver)**
- \* **Twelve Drummers Drumming**   **Twelve articles of belief we profess when we say The Apostles Creed**


