

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

The next great event in our parish's Centennial Celebration will be in a month, at the 4pm Mass on Saturday March 7. It is uncertain as we go to press who will be the celebrant of that Mass. I invited Cardinal Dolan three years ago. He gladly accepted the invitation three months ago. But something surprising and bigger than our parish anniversary happened after that day: a new Archbishop was appointed for the Archdiocese of New York. That brings a change of obligations, and possibly of calendars, for Cardinal Dolan.

But you can still save that day — Saturday March 7 — for this special event: the 4pm Mass and a reception afterwards in our gymnasium, to celebrate the signing by His Eminence Patrick Cardinal Hayes on March 7, 1926, of the letter of incorporation for the new Parish of Saint Teresa in West New Brighton. And after the Mass all are welcome to proceed to a reception with food and drink in our Gym and Parish Hall, which is named for our founding pastor: Monsignor Philip Conran.

Today and during this week, as we prepare for his formal installation as the successor to our Cardinal Timothy Dolan, please join in praying for our new Archbishop of the Archdiocese of New York: the Most Reverend Ronald A. Hicks.

I thought you would like to know more about his background, and perhaps recognize some reasons that led to the choice of Pope Leo XIV to move Bishop Ronald Hicks from Joliet, Illinois, to us, and to make him the spiritual leader for more than two million Catholics in the ten counties of our Archdiocese of New York—starting of course with Staten Island, then Manhattan, Bronx, Westchester, Rockland, Orange, Dutchess, Putnam, Ulster and Sullivan.

I am sure that there will be a lot written about Bishop Ronald Hicks this week. Here is the information printed in the online Monthly Bulletin of the Archdiocese after the announcement of his appointment in December:

Bishop Ronald Aldon Hicks was born on August 4, 1967, in Harvey, Illinois, to Ronald and Roselee Hicks. He has a younger brother, Rick. He grew up in South Holland, Illinois, where he attended St. Jude the Apostle Parish and Elementary School. He graduated from Quigley Preparatory Seminary in 1985. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy from Niles College of Loyola University, Chicago, in 1989. He earned his Master of Divinity degree in 1994 and his Doctor of Ministry degree in 2003 from the University of St. Mary of the Lake in Mundelein, Illinois.

Bishop Hicks was ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Chicago on May 21, 1994. He served as associate pastor of Our Lady of Mercy Parish in Chicago from 1994 to 1996, and St. Elizabeth Seton Parish in Orland Hills, Illinois, from 1996 to 1999. From 1999 to 2005, he lived and served at St. Joseph College Seminary in Chicago as the dean of formation.

With permission from his Archbishop, Cardinal Francis George, Bishop Hicks moved in July 2005 from Chicago to El Salvador to begin five years as regional director of Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH) in Central America – a home dedicated to caring for more than 3,400 orphaned and abandoned children in nine Latin American and Caribbean countries.

From 2010 to 2014, Bishop Hicks served as the dean of formation for seminarians at Mundelein Seminary in Chicago. On Sundays, he assisted with weekend Masses at St. Jerome Parish in the Rogers Park neighborhood of Chicago.

On January 1, 2015, Bishop Hicks was appointed vicar general of the Archdiocese of Chicago by Cardinal Blase Cupich. On September 17, 2018, he was ordained an auxiliary bishop of the archdiocese at Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago.

On July 17, 2020, it was announced that Pope Francis had named Bishop Hicks as the sixth bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Joliet, Illinois. He was installed in the Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus in Joliet on September 29, 2020.

And in December 2025, Bishop Hicks was appointed by Pope Leo XIV to become the next Archbishop of New York. He succeeds His Eminence Timothy Cardinal Dolan. There will be a Vespers Service in Saint Patrick's Cathedral Thursday evening February 5 at 5pm. The Mass of Installation for the new Archbishop will be on Friday February 6, at 2pm.

I expect that both events will be televised as they happen on the EWTN (Eternal Word Television Network) and NET stations in our area.




