

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Teresa Church,

By the time you read this letter, Cardinal Timothy Dolan will have completed seventeen years of great responsibility as Archbishop of New York. And we will have welcomed his successor, Archbishop Ronald Hicks, at an Installation Mass in Saint Patrick's Cathedral on Friday February 6. I thank God our Father for giving us Cardinal Dolan, with his joyful faith, wisdom, kindness, and personal interest in all of us, to be our spiritual leader for so long and so well. And now we will be thanking God and praying at every Mass for his successor, Archbishop Ronald Hicks. May he too have a great experience here in New York - bringing his own talents and experience to our Archdiocese, and leading us forward to salvation, in service to God and to all people.

So we must now get ourselves ready for the Season of Lent, which starts with Ash Wednesday, on February 18. Ash Wednesday is a day that can set the pattern for a person's spiritually satisfying or sadly lackadaisical Lent. Planning to come to church and to receive ashes is a reminder of our mortality and of our personal sins. On Ash Wednesday we anticipate God's judgment for what we have done and what we have failed to do. We receive ashes and hear these somber words: Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.

You don't have to be holy to make a good Lent, but you do have to be humble and responsible. It is like the simple advice I learned on the first day of high school: keep the rules, and the rules will keep you. That applies in so many areas of life: in your school, in your marriage, in your job, in your family, in maintaining health.

Here are the traditional official rules for Lent that Catholic people should keep. Reminded each year by our bishops, all Catholics should follow them to make a meaningful Lent, avoid detours and pitfalls, and be on the highway to heaven. You can receive ashes during and after our three Masses on Ash Wednesday: 8:30, 12 Noon, 7:30pm. Especially for children and workers, we also give ashes in church between 3:30 and 4:30.

Praying on Ash Wednesday and making some promises is only a good start. There is more to do.

1. Praying more often is a big advantage for people who want to be good. Be sure to come to Mass and receive Holy Communion worthily every Sunday. Our parish Mass schedule is: Saturday at 4pm, Sunday at 7:30, 9am in St. Nicholas Chapel, 10:30, 12:30 and 5pm.

2. How about finding out what happens if you show up for some weekday Masses during Lent? We have 8:30 Masses every Monday to Saturday, and 12 Noon Masses on Tuesdays, Wednesdays Thursdays, Fridays.

3. A great special practice during Lent is called MAKING THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS. We do that together in church every Friday at 7:30pm. We have good handouts for you to use, and it takes about 40 minutes.

4. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. To explain:

a) Fasting means eating only one full meal on these important days. Two smaller meals may be eaten: smaller quantity, and no snacking. Ages 18 to 59 are obligated; others should also do this if possible for them.

b) Abstinence means not eating meat or poultry. People 14 and older must abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. Plan not to forget. People of other ages should join them if possible.

5. Lent is a special time to be charitable. We ought to give to God more of our time, our talent, and our treasure. Who should you give more of your time, talent, and treasure to? To the One who gave you life itself, the One who will be your judge when you die. Give to maintain churches where people can pray, to schools so that every generation learns about God and religious truth. To people who enabled you to have good things in this life. To the institutions that make the world a better place. Hoarding as if you can take any possessions with you when you die, or ignoring what people need now even though you can help them, hurts you and them.

6. Make a confession that relieves you of guilt and improves your peace of mind and your future. There are people in church every Saturday for confession, from Noon to 1pm. They ask for and receive God's forgiveness for their sins. This Sacrament—best name is Reconciliation, also known as Penance and as Confession- is private and anonymous. We use the confessionals along the rear wall of the church.

7. The Big Three of Lent are Prayer - Fasting - Almsgiving. That last one has many avenues you can take. Contributing regularly and appropriately to keep our doors open is every parishioner's duty. But charity starts at a higher level: where you give to people without getting anything back.

Hoping that all this informs us and encourages each of us to make this a very good Lent,
