# PASTOR'S NOTE "RELAY FOR LIFE" SATURDAY, JUNE 20<sup>TH</sup>

Last year Arlington High School decided to increase the involvement of the community in its Annual Relay for Life. Our Parish hosted a team that was tremendously successful. We were awarded for being the group that raised the most money. Everybody that participated had a great time and indicated they wanted to do it again and get even more involved. As a result we are going to 'host' TWO teams this year: one for more 'mature' parishioners, and one for the younger parishioners. This allows us two tents on the field-something we could have used last year, and hopefully will bring even greater participation. All of us have been affected by cancer, and "Relay for Life" is a way to express our concern.
