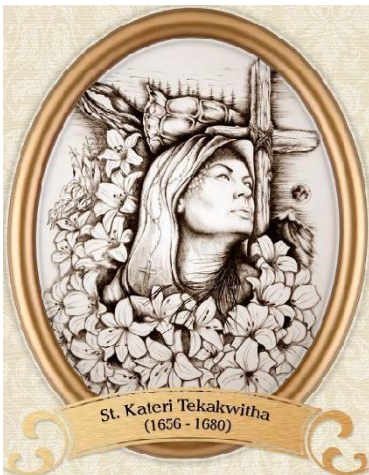

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Jesus gave the twelve disciples authority over unclean spirits and sent them out to preach and heal the sick. He advised them to bring nothing with them and to shake the dust from their feet of any town where they had not been welcomed. Jesus wanted them to understand what they would need to do in his place after his death.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

July 12, 2015

"Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits... So they went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them."... "In love he destined us for adoption to himself through Jesus Christ in accord with the favor of his will."

The gospel of Mark opened with Jesus proclaiming the presence of the kingdom and the need for repentance. He now sends His chosen Twelve to do the same. It is easy to picture them going in pairs, see what they are carrying and wearing, perhaps one to speak, the other to support in prayer. As friends they have been 'summoned' indicating a sense of urgency. As part of the chosen band, off they go. Maybe their message is the same as that spoken by Pope Francis: 'Jesus Christ loves you, He gave His life for you, and now He is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you. He accompanies you.' The art of accompaniment! The words of the classic song ring true: 'You'll never walk alone.'

Is the Lord not summoning everyone to hear His call and continue His mission? What will I do about it?

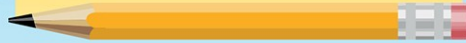
