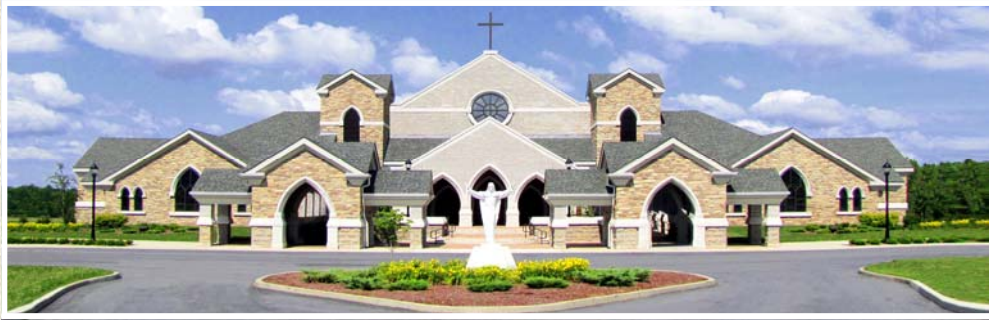

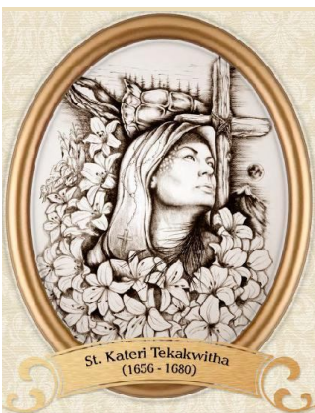

14th Edition of New York Encounter with Bryan Stevenson, David Brooks, Francis Collins, Helen Joyce, Daniel Linpinski, Patrick Keefe, and Many Others

The **2022 NEW YORK ENCOUNTER**, "This Urge for the Truth," will take place **February 18-20** in person and live-streamed from the Metropolitan Pavilion, 125 West 18th Street in Manhattan. 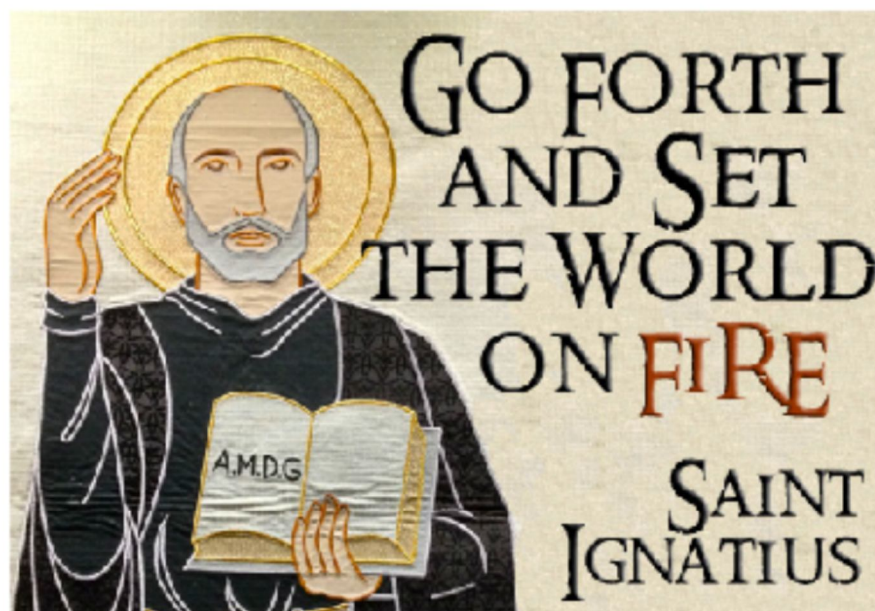
