

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

CHRIST THE KING:

Today we end the Liturgical year with the feast of Christ the King, Jesus' throne is not made of silver or gold but of wood. His crown is thorns that pierce his skull. His robes are hoisted upon him in mockery. He has no army or money. He was stripped naked and nailed to his death bed the Cross. Behold our King who gave everything to save us. Next Weekend we begin the season of Advent as we anticipate the celebration of Christmas. How will you use this hopeful season in preparation of the Birthday of our King.

WITNESS TO CHRIST THE KING

- * Fr. Miguel Pro was born to a family of miners in Guadalupe, Mexico in 1891. He was a very spiritual child.
- *At 20 years old Miguel embraced his passion to live for the Kingdom of Jesus Christ.
- *By that time it was dangerous to be a Catholic in Mexico, even more dangerous to be a priest.
- *By 1914 the seminary was closed and the seminarians fled to Texas and New Mexico.
- *Fr. Miguel continued his education, eventually being sent to study in Spain and in Belgium.
- *Meanwhile, back in Mexico, a new constitution made it illegal for Catholics to practice their faith outside of a few designated churches. The country continually looked for ways to destroy the faith.
- *The situation in Mexico was grave. The new president, Calles, declared that he had a personal hatred for Jesus Christ and vigorously enforced anti-Catholic measures throughout the country.
- *Fr. Miguel Pro found ways to reach out to the people.
- *He would come in the middle of the night dressed as a beggar and baptize infants, bless marriages and celebrate Mass.
- *The government learned about him and sought out ways to discredit him while looking to arrest him.
- *He was accused of involvement in an assassination attempt on the former president; caught, arrested and quickly sent to the firing squad.
- *Fr. Pro's last words were, —Viva Cristo Rey! Long Live Christ the King!
- *Governments rise and fall, countries rise and fall, but the Kingdom of God is forever.
- *We are the soldiers of this Kingdom.

Reflections

- *Our personal dedication to God will keep us always on target, sustain us through life and enable us to turn again to God after momentary lapses.
 - *The trials of life do not destroy but purify the person of faith.
 - *We must be ready when the spirit inspires us to give in ways that are outside our comfort zone, ways that can unite us with Jesus who gave him-self totally on the cross for us.
 - *Only when the time comes will each of us know the reality of what we have given to our neighbor and to God.

TESTIMONIO DE CRISTO REY

*Padre Miguel Pro nació a una familia de mineros en Guadalupe, México, en 1891. El fue un niño muy espiritual.

*A los 20 años el Padre Miguel aceptó su pasión de vivir para el reino de Jesucristo.

*En aquel entonces era peligroso ser un católico en México, aún más peligroso para ser un sacerdote.

*En 1914 el seminario fue cerrado y los seminaristas huyeron a Texas y Nuevo México.

*El Padre Miguel continuó su educación, finalmente lo enviaron a estudiar a España y Bélgica.

*Mientras tanto, de vuelta en México, una nueva constitución hizo ilegal que los católicos practican su fe fuera de unas pocas designadas iglesias. El país continuamente buscó formas de destruir la fe.

*La situación en México era grave. El nuevo presidente, Calles, declaró que tuvo un odio personal a Jesucristo y forzó estrictamente las medidas anti-católicos en todo el país.

*El Padre Miguel Pro encontró formas de llegar a la gente.

*Venía en el medio de la noche vestido de mendigo y bautizo bebés, bendecido los matrimonios y celebró la Santa Misa.

*El gobierno supo de Él y buscó maneras de desacreditarlo con vistas a su detención.

*Fue acusado de participar en un intento de asesinato del ex presidente; capturado, detenido y enviado rápidamente a un pelotón de fusilamiento.

*Las últimas palabras de Padre Miguel fueron "¡Viva Cristo Rey!"

*Los gobiernos suben y bajan, los países suben y bajan, pero el reino de Dios es para siempre.

*Somos los soldados de este Reino.
