



# From the Pastor's Desk ...

We are cautiously and excitedly entering the second phase of our return to our regular activities, beginning the process of a gradual reopening. Slowly a New Normalcy will evolve. Join me thanking our good Lord for the providential care and continue praying for all affected.

The Archdiocese of New York has released some new guidelines regarding the Return to Mass. As we continue to transition back to the public celebration of Mass, please note the following updates:

We begin three weekday Masses this week on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 8:00 am.

Weekend Masses at Our Lady Queen of Peace beginning Saturday the 27<sup>th</sup> will be 4:00 pm on Saturday, and Sundays at 7:00 am, 9:00 am and 11:00 am. Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes will be Sundays at 10:00 am.

Time changes have been made to allow our best efforts for sanitizing and social distancing to help everyone to be safe.

Thank you for your continued prayers and support during this stressful time. Remember, we are in this together!

All phases require social distancing and wearing masks. Anyone coming into the church MUST wear a mask. Remember we do this to protect others so if we are coming to church we above all must be looking to protect one another. In the pews there will be no missalettes or hymnals. This means we have to pay even closer attention to listening to the readings and the repertoire of hymns may be reduced to some familiar favorites.

As you come for Communion, you will have to keep a six feet social distance. The Communion ministers will be wearing masks. Holy Communion will only be received in the hand.

At the end of Mass the priest will not be able to greet you at the back of the church. You will be asked to leave through the exit door and not congregate anywhere in the church.

We will all need to adjust to remain healthy and protect the health of others. Remember to keep our parish family in your prayers each day and we will get through this together.

After a long Lenten and Easter season, as well as the solemnities of Pentecost, Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi, we find ourselves back in Ordinary Time, starting at week 13th Ordinary Time consists of two parts: the winter portion from the day after the Baptism of Jesus until the day before Ash Wednesday, and the longer portion in summer and autumn which will go until the 1st Sunday of Advent on November 28th and 29th.

Ordinary Time is the season of discipleship. The gospels of Ordinary Time give us Christ's lessons on daily living of our faith. This being Cycle A for the readings, we will hear from St. Matthew's gospel which contains beautiful parables, miracles, and discourses of Jesus. Let us live the Christian life in all the "ordinary" situations of life.

# Quick Overview

- · The obligation to attend Sunday Mass is suspended until further notice
- Those who are at a higher risk for COVID-19 (i.e., those who are older than 65 or who have underlying health conditions) are urged not to come to church for Mass
  - Those who cannot attend Mass may be encouraged to spend time daily reading the Scriptures, praying with their families, watching a broadcast or live-streamed Mass, and making an act of spiritual communion.
- Those who feel in any way sick (e.g., oral temperature higher than 99.5°F, cough, chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell) or who are worried about attendance should not enter the church.
- In accord with current state policy, the faithful (over 2 years old) must wear cloth face coverings when in public, including when they come to church.
- Parishioners should sanitize their hands prior to entering the church for Mass or other public prayer opportunities.
- All present at Mass should sit 6 feet or more away from others.


