### AFTERWORD...Fr. Dave Howell

**HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!!** ...A very happy Father's Day to all our dads, stepfathers, grandfathers and all the men who mentor others. I truly hope that the love and affection shown to you this weekend will last into the weeks ahead! I would also like to thank you for your very important ministry to your family, for it imitates God! For like God, a father gives life. The care and concern of a dad, his love and service to his child(ren) is a real reflection of God's own commitment to us all. In many ways, the ministry of a father is one of the most important revelations of God's love to his child(ren). When we think about what a kind and loving father brings to his family, it's rather easy to understand why the Scriptures call God a Father! Happy Father's Day to all the dads among us! Keep up the great ministry – it is one of the best ways we can teach our children about the love of God, who is a Father to us all!

**WHO MATTERS** ...When the phrase, *Black Lives Matter* were first chanted by people protesting the death of an unarmed African-American some people took exception to the statement. Their response was "all lives matter" or "Blue lives matter". What we failed to hear was not that one group is more important than another, but that all lives matter *EQUALLY* no group matters more than any other. What the phrase intended to make clear is that in our nation which promises "liberty and justice for all" that is all too often not true for people of color. Black people, Native American people, Hispanic people have experienced the genuine pain of being less than equal. The truth is Black lives matter, red lives matter, brown lives matter; white lives matter, blue lives matter, unborn lives matter. All lives matter *EQUALLY* – no one matters more or less. Even in the Church, we know that all people are equal in the sight of God (God has no favorites). This is a fundamental teaching of the Gospels and also the teaching of the Church. Sadly, that hasn't always been the way we have acted. There are churches in this country that had separate seating, usually in a balcony for Black Catholics and, in some cases, separate parishes were created for Black Catholics to separate them from white Catholics.

Racism, sexism and any attitude that says some people matter less and others more is wrong. The very real demand for equal justice for all people should lead us all to examine our own attitudes toward others. Any time we demean, or think less of a person because they are "one of those people" we have discriminated against them.

As we approach the Fourth of July and the 224<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Declaration of Independence, I hope that all Americans can dedicate themselves anew to the principles stated in that inspiring document that all of us are created equal and every people is endowed by our Creator with fundamental rights. Our national constitution commits us to creating a "more perfect society". We have changed a lot since our founding, but there is still much to do.
