THE SCRUTINIES ... There are three cycles to the Lectionary. Cycles A-B & C. Cycle A. which we are using this year, it provides the Scripture that were used in the days Lent was taking shape. (Sometime in the 3rd & 4th centuries.) Just as Lent evolved as a time of preparation for the reception of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist on Holy Saturday, the readings for Lent were chosen with those same Sacraments in mind. The Third, Fourth & Fifth Sundays of Lent are Scrutiny Sundays. The Gospel of each Sunday Liturgy is from John and each invites both our catechumen and the whole assembly to look at, to scrutinize our lives through the lens of the Gospel. The Gospel of the Third Sunday is from John 4 and tells the story of the nameless woman of Samaria who meets Jesus at Jacob's Well at the Samaritan town of Shechem. An outcast among her own people, she comes seeking water to quench her thirst. It was at the well she encounters Jesus who offers her living water. In her conversation with Jesus, she finds the One who is able to satisfy her deepest thirsts that go far beyond water. To prepare for Sunday, those chosen for the Easter Sacraments are invited to reflect on the deepest desire of our hearts and how these might be satisfied by Christ.

SCRUTINY EXPERIENCE ... For the next three Wednesdays, after our simple Soup Supper at 6 pm and Stations at 6:30 pm, our catechumen and their sponsors will spend an hour in preparation for Sunday's Gospel The experience is open to the catechumen, their sponsors **and anyone** who would like to participate. All you need to do is show up! I would ask participants to "fast from drinking" anything for a few hours on Wednesday, March 8, in preparation for the reflection.

DIFFERENT VOICES... This Lent we are going to continue to add to our experience of the Stations of the Cross on Wednesday evening. Each week as we pray the Stations, we will stop at one of them and one of our parishioners will offer their personal reflection on what that station means to him or her. This coming Wednesday, March 8, Vince Maysura will share his reflection with us Join us in church or on line for the Stations on Wednesday evenings of Lent starting at 7 pm.
