One of the items which has gravitated far too long on the lower half of the “to do” list is the restoration and repair of the tabernacle in the church. You may notice us struggling at times to get it open; the lock mechanism has not functioned correctly for as long as I’ve been here. We’ve engaged a restoration company to remove and refinish it, and repair or replace the lock. To that end, we’ll be setting up a temporary tabernacle on the high altar in the next week or two; we’re assured the original will be back, better than new, well before Easter.

This Wednesday, March 6, is **Ash Wednesday**, the beginning of the season of Lent. The schedule is listed above; the collection that day will be given to Catholic Charities of Orange, Sullivan, and Ulster, for the works of mercy that agency does right in our own community.

Ash Wednesday is a day of *fast* and *abstinence*. Fasting means taking only one full meal during the day, and refraining from snacking between meals. Fasting applies to those ages 18 to 59. Abstinence means not eating meat on a particular day, and applies to those ages 14 and up. Those who are not obliged to fast or abstain are encouraged to do so, to the extent that they are able. Of course, there are many other things, in addition to food, that we can “fast” from during Lent: social media, television, radio—the possibilities are endless. The goal is to reach a point of self-control that’s necessary if we want to make continued progress on the path of holiness.

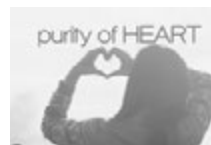

LENTEN NORMS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of
fast and abstinence.

All Fridays of Lent are days of *abstinence from Meat.*

ABSTINENCE forbids the eating of meat and is observed from the 14th birthday on.

FASTING means that one full meal may be taken. Two smaller meals may be taken to maintain strength, but these taken together should not equal another full meal. Fasting obliges from the 18th birthday to the 59th birthday.

The Stations of the Cross will be prayed each Friday during Lent at 7:00pm. One new addition to our spiritual regimen: after Stations each week, the presider will offer a *fervorino*, a short spiritual talk or exhortation.

In an effort to make the sacrament of Penance more readily available, we're going to hear confessions after every Sunday Mass during the season of Lent, in addition to the regularly-scheduled time on Saturday afternoons. In addition, confessions will be heard on Saturday mornings in the chapel sacristy following the 8:00am Mass. We've also purchased copies of *The Magnificat Lenten Companion*. These are available (one per family) today; if we run out, we'll order more.

Additional opportunities for spiritual growth abound. They include:
