I am most pleased with and grateful for the positive reaction to the “unveiling” of the church last weekend. This is as much a testament to the generosity of all who contributed to the *Renew+Rebuild* capital campaign as much as it is to the contractors who did the work.

There have been many questions as to what is what in the newly-reconfigured entry area.

- The vestibule (in church parlance, the *narthex*) will be fronted with glass, so that it will double as a place for parents with small children, should they need to take a walk. (We are not calling it a “crying room,” for reasons I will share next week.)
- As one enters the church, the room immediately to the left is a lavatory; the room in front of that, accessible from the *nave* (the main part of the church), is a confessional.
- The room to the right – adjacent to the tower room – will be a small sacristy and storage area; we will probably relocate the altar server vestments here.

As to some other questions:

- There are several new niches for the statues. Until those are finished, and we determine who will be located where, most of the statues will reside in the sanctuary. The seventh and eighth stations of the cross will also be relocated.
- The floor in the narthex will consist of ceramic tile, over which we will place some carpeted mats in the winter. Hopefully, these will capture the salt, moisture, etc., before they’re tracked into the church.

As with any construction project, there are inevitable delays. Some items – for example, the new glass doors and the ceiling tiles – will be delivered later than we had expected. Hopefully, we’ll see some progress each week until the whole thing is completed.

Several years ago, the Orange County Sheriff’s Department began an initiative called *Operation Archangel*; this was in response to the now all-too-common occurrence of gun violence in houses of worship. While several of our parishioners have attended various active-shooter trainings, we would like to formalize the establishment of a Parish Safety Committee. To that end, I would invite any current or former law enforcement personnel who would like to take part to contact me, so that we can get a group together. In addition, there is a “parish safety training workshop” on Thursday, October 17; the flyer is included on page 6 of today’s bulletin.

Every few years, each parish is expected to undertake an Increased Offertory Campaign; our turn is this fall. To that end, I will speak briefly at each Mass the weekend of October 19/20. In preparation, I will be devoting this space to an assessment/explanation of the parish’s spiritual and financial condition over the next three weeks.
