

Hear, Listen, Respond, Act!



Lord, open my heart, my ears and my mind to hear your call. Then, let me respond and act according to your will.

Today's readings, for the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, are about listening to the Lord and heeding His call. In Old Testament times, most of the calling of prophets seemed to invoke a great drama, except for Samuel. For example in Genesis 12, we see a 75 year old Abraham leaving his homeland, Harran, with his elderly wife and all his valued possessions in response to God's promise to make of him a great nation. In Exodus 3, we learn that the voice of God came from a burning

bush, calling Moses to liberate the Israelites from their slavery in Egypt. The Old Testament seems to suggest that God chose people who were hesitant to follow His command; but not Samuel.

Samuel was born to Hannah long after her normal childbearing years had ended, and he was placed in the care of the temple priests where he spent much time watching over the Ark of the Covenant. The young Samuel was eager to please, and when he heard his name called in the middle of the night, he raced to the high priest Eli saying, "Here I am, you called me." Eli denied having called Samuel and told him to return to sleep. A second time an identical sequence of events occurred. The third time Samuel went to Eli, Eli realized who was the source of the voice and instructed Eli, if it happened again, to respond, "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening." Eli's enlightening response allows us to realize that something very important is about to happen to Samuel.

The next time that God called out to Samuel, the eager youth enthusiastically responded, "**Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening.**" Samuel discerned God's call to him and became a selfless prophet who truly listened to the voice of God, and "the Lord was with him, not permitting any word of his to be without effect."

Similar to what Eli did in Reading I, John does in the Gospel. He exclaimed to his followers as he watched Jesus walk by, "Behold, the Lamb of God." When Jesus asked John's disciples what they were looking for, they responded "Rabbi" or teacher. In response to their inquiry as to where He was staying, Jesus' answer was very simple and straight forward, "Come, and you will see." We contemplate about the depth of meaning of the word "see." Jesus, the Teacher, is educating His new companions through first-hand observation. Jesus offered His soon to be disciples the opportunity to hear – to really listen. Then they were able to discern and respond; finally to act. After staying the night with Christ, Andrew left to find his brother Simon and bring him back to Jesus. Andrew excitedly told Simon, "We have found the Messiah." Jesus welcomed Simon to His then small group and gave him a new name.

What are we to do in these unprecedented times of pandemic illness, political turmoil and unrest? We must hear, but even more so, we must listen to the right voices. Let us heed God's call. Let us open our hearts, our ears and our minds to listen carefully to discern what He is saying. May our response always be "Here I am Lord; I come to do your will."
