

The Covenant is Fulfilled



Today's Gospel for the Feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for Body of Christ) is a narrative taken from the Passion according to St. Mark that we read on Palm Sunday, and focuses on the covenant that is offered by Jesus near the end of the Last Supper.

In the ancient world, to share a meal was to invite your guests into an environment of hospitality and protection that makes them family. The Passover meal was a reminder of God's graciousness and protection of the Israelites. God extended a covenant to them as they were about to be freed from captivity in Egypt.

We see many parallels when we compare today's readings and events to Old Testament times. Passover is the commemoration of the Angel of Death "passing over" the homes of Israelites being held captive in Egypt. The symbol used by the angel to identify which households to spare was the blood of a sacrificial lamb prominently displayed on their door step.

Jesus and His disciples have convened just outside the city of Jerusalem. They, along with many other visitors, are on their way to the city to celebrate a Passover meal during the Feast of Unleavened Bread. The sacrificial lambs have already been slaughtered in the Temple in Jerusalem. Today's Gospel opens with Jesus telling two of His disciples to go to the city and find a man bearing a jug of water. The disciples carry out Jesus' instructions precisely, and Jesus welcomes His family at sundown in the Upper Room in Jerusalem.

In the greatest act of love of all time, God gave to us the Gift of His only Son, Jesus Christ, to be our Redeemer, our Savior. We see a manifestation of this love in the words spoken by Jesus at the Last Supper: "He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, 'Take it; this is my body.' Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them...He said to them, 'This is my blood of the covenant which will be shed for many.'" (*Mark 14:22-26*)

St. Paul, in writing of these same events of the Last Supper in a letter to the Corinthians, relates how Jesus took bread, broke it and gave it to the disciples saying, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." Then Jesus gave them the cup of wine: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this as often as you drink it in remembrance of me." In the magnificence of the Most Holy Eucharist, His Body and Blood, we are nourished and renewed in Christ. We eat, we drink, and we are satisfied!

The covenant is fulfilled. The Body and Blood sacrifice of Christ on the Cross redeems and restores our relationship with God permanently; it spares us from death. Every Eucharist that we celebrate highlights these words. So we follow Christ's wish, "Do this in remembrance of me."

The Eucharist



On this feast of The Body and Blood of Christ as I reflected on the different aspects of Eucharist, somehow thinking of Eucharist as a meal was more comfortable for me. We know that Eucharist in terms of a meal has an ancient and honorable tradition. All of us eat. Eating is an important social time when we can share.

Children are always hungry. This reminds me of a parish priest who visited a 5th grade classroom and one of the students asked, “Do we eat in heaven?” When the priest answered, “No, we do not eat in heaven.” The boy’s face fell and he said, “Gosh, Father, eating is half the fun of living.” In understanding the mysteries of God, it seems easier to go from the known to the unknown. Jesus did this often – He chose a meal as a way to give of Himself.

Today in our society the values expressed by meals have somewhat been lessened. Latin cultures seem to have a better understanding of the social advantage of sharing meals. With our fast food places, we can often make the mistake of thinking that food is the most important thing about mealtimes. Many families are seldom together for meals because of their outside of the home activities.

We all enjoy receiving dinner invitations – and not always just because of the food. We appreciate the thoughtfulness of the one extending the invitation, the enjoyment of coming together with friends, and the conversation. All are important and, even if the food is not the best, we look back on that occasion and say THAT WAS A GOOD MEAL. It seems Good Friends make any food taste better.

In the time of Christ, this was even more true. Meals were sacred. To break bread with someone was a pledge of solidarity and friendship. During more formal meals, there would be much dialogue and sharing. Jesus had participated in a rather extensive ministry of eating with the tax collectors, prostitutes, and others whom the scribes and Pharisees objected to. But the fact that He ate with sinners spoke of acceptance and forgiveness.

As Jesus asked the disciples at the feeding of the 5,000 to care for His followers, so does He ask that of us today. We may not have the gifts to be Jesus for a multitude, but each of us can bring His presence to one other person.




Totus Tuus for Special Needs
