

Pastor's Notes

Today's Pastor's Notes is not meant to be read as an under 5 minute homily that I have promoted so often. It is meant to be read with frequent pauses for reflection and meditation. Our Liturgical Year is "cymbalized" as a Symphony of Love. So, grab a cup of hot coffee, tea or water, sit back, read slowly and enjoy.

The King of Glory Comes



Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King, the culmination of the Church's Liturgical Year. We have likened the Liturgical year to a great symphony of love. We are now in the final movement of that symphony. The strings and reeds carry repeated melodies of miracles, parables, and love throughout. Clanging cymbals keynote high points; roaring drums, brass and bass mark the awesome occasions throughout the life of Christ. I have tried to blend this Hymn to today's readings. We have included other scriptural references as needed. Listen now to the opening majestic beat of the refrain:

Refrain:

The King of Glory comes, the nation rejoices;

Open the gates before Him lift up your voices!

In the Gospel at the Procession used on Palm Sunday (*Mark 11:1-10*), we hear Jesus directing two of His disciples to go into Jerusalem where they will find a colt, tethered at a gate outside on a street. After convincing bystanders that their Master needed it, the disciples brought the colt to Jesus. "Many people spread their cloaks on the road. (They) kept crying out: 'Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come! Hosanna in the highest!'"

Verse 1

Who is the King of Glory, how shall we call Him?

He is Emmanuel, the promised of ages.

The word Emmanuel (meaning God with us) is found three times in the bible: twice in Isaiah 7:14 and 8:8 and once in Matthew 1:22-23. Matthew understood that Jesus was the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy. After His Resurrection, Jesus made this promise "I am with you always, even to the end of the age." In our Second Reading today from the Book of Revelation 1:5-8, we hear Jesus' prophetic words: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the one who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

Verse 2

In all of Galilee in city or village

He goes among His people curing their illness.

Let's look back to the time right after John baptized Jesus in the River Jordan. Shortly thereafter, we see Jesus walking near the Sea of Galilee selecting His disciples and then traveling throughout the region with them, preaching, teaching and curing those who approached Him – the blind, the lame and the lepers. He will cure us as well; all we have to do is ask.

Verse 3

Sing then of David's Son, our Savior and Brother

In all of Galilee was never another.

Reflect again on the scripture reading following the Refrain. Then return to our Second Reading from Revelation: "To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, who has made us into a kingdom, priests for his God and Father,

"TO HIM BE GLORY AND POWER FOREVER AND EVER."




