### *Living Our New Life*

The haunting melody of Hosea has been reverberating in my mind all week. I had to look further into the verses to see how its promises might relate to today's Readings. The word Hosea is from the Hebrew and means salvation, help. Hosea was the first of 12 minor prophets in the Hebrew Bible. Hosea, living in the 8<sup>th</sup> century BC, was seen as a prophet of doom. Under his message of destruction was a foretelling of restoration. The prophecy of Hosea centered on God's unending love toward a sinful Israel whose inhabitants had fallen away and were worshipping other gods. From the hymn Hosea:

*"Come back to me with all your heart. Don't let fear keep us apart.*

*Long have I waited for your coming home to me and living deeply our new life."*

*"The wilderness will lead you to your heart where I will speak.*

***Integrity and justice with tenderness, you shall know."***

*"You shall sleep **secure with peace**; **faithfulness** will be your joy."*

In our second Reading today, we hear words addressed by Saint Paul to Timothy. Timothy was a young man of mixed parentage, a Jewish mother and a Greek father. Paul converted Timothy while on his second missionary journey, and Timothy along with Silas became companions on Paul's subsequent journeys. The second verse above is illustrated in the advice written by Paul.

In the Judeo-Christian tradition, the primary responsibility of rulers is to work for the common good by maintaining justice for all. Hence Paul advises Timothy and his community to offer supplications, prayers and petitions for kings and for all in authority. Paul writes that these supplications would be pleasing to God, "For there is one God. There is also one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as ransom for all" (1 Tim 2:6).

The dishonest steward in today's Gospel, Luke 16:1-13, is the complete opposite of both the second and third verses quoted above. When he was caught squandering his master's property, the dishonest steward decided to reduce the debts owed to his master, thinking that he could find favor with the debtors and be welcomed into their homes after the steward had been removed from his position. The master "praised" the steward for acting prudently. Jesus declares that the steward acts like a child of this world.

Jesus wants us to exercise the attributes of both the second and third verses. He wants us to exemplify integrity, justice and faithfulness. Jesus tells us, "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones....No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon." We must choose to whom we will be faithful.

Together let us live this new life to which Jesus calls us. With integrity and faithfulness in our hearts, we can follow the guidance of Jesus to His home and find security and joy in His peace in our new lives.



## We did it!

We stuffed the truck! In true Curé community spirit, we set records for food gathering at a parish for Catholic Charities. Last weekend, Curé donated 4,982 pounds of food compared to 1,726 in August. 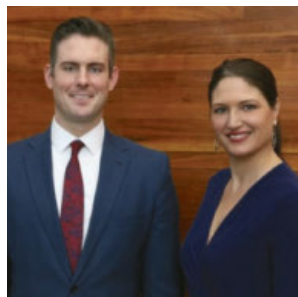

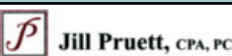
