

A Four Letter Words Guide to Lent

Over the past few weeks, we have been examining St. Matthew's account of Our Lord Jesus Christ teaching His disciples how to find true happiness in God, and how to be good, faithful followers of Himself, valuing actions over words.

Today we have only three days left before Lent begins on February 22, Ash Wednesday. I would like to share with you my Four-Letter-Words Guide to celebrating Lent. Many of these will be very familiar to you, others not as much so; but you will have an opportunity to customize the list and make it your own.

High on my list are three familiar words: **pray**, **fast** and give **alms**. Also prominent in the guide are **love**, **acts** (of kindness), **read** (an inspirational book), **hope**, and **care**. Obviously, this list is not complete. It is

by you. I want each of you to customize your own list. Make it personal. Choose at least six words – one for every week of Lent. Make it be something that you want to concentrate on during Lent, something that will help you draw closer to Our Lord Jesus. Write this list on a piece of paper. Fold this paper and put it in your pocket. Carry it with you throughout Lent. Add to it whenever you want to.

First on my list is love, a special type of love known as agape, an unconditional love.

St. Paul in his First Letter to the Corinthians describes the effect of great spiritual gifts – speaking in angelic tongues, prophesying, almsgiving – but without love, as *nothing*. He tells us eight things that love is: patient, kind, rejoices in truth, never fails, etc. He also relates what love is not: jealous, pompous, inflated, rude, etc. St. Paul concludes, "So faith, hope and love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love."

Look closely at a Crucifix. We have there, without a doubt, the greatest example of pure, unconditional love that could ever be. Christ's love for us IS kind, patient; it hears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. It never fails. This is the kind of love that we should always strive for, not only throughout these forty days, but throughout all our lives.

A three-day trip begins with one day; a week-long trip begins with one day. Our forty days journey through Lent begins with one day. Take each day – one at a time – and with the guidance of the Holy Spirit make it the best day that you can. Have faith, pray a little, hope a little, and love a lot. "For the greatest of these is love."





KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FAITH IN ACTION

Pro Life Programs

The fourth program area of the Knights is Pro-Life Activities in the parish. You have heard in previous weeks of our involvement in Community, Family and Faith programs. This week we highlight our 2022 involvement in programs supporting Pro-Life activities in the parish. Our Knights council disbursed over \$3,175 and contributed 56 hours in support of Pro-Life based programs.
