

Triduum, An Exquisite Gift of Love

Jesus Christ broke the bonds of death! He is risen from the dead!

The summit of our Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum. The Triduum, chronologically three days, is liturgically one day, unfolding the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. It begins the evening of Holy Thursday with the Mass of the Lord's Supper and continues through the evening of Easter Sunday. On Good Friday, Jesus offered the ultimate gift of love, the sacrifice of Himself through His suffering and death on the cross. Holy Saturday – a day of supreme quiet, a great silence in our liturgy – Jesus was in the tomb. We wait at the tomb in peaceful expectation of a brilliant future.

At the Easter Vigil, we celebrate the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord. We break the great silence, going from darkness into the Light of Christ. We punctuate our songs and prayers with Alleluias; we rejoice in the Risen Lord. It is symbolic, that after a six weeks absence from our liturgy, the words, first voiced by a chorus of angels at Christmas over 2000 years ago, are once again sung at Easter: *Gloria in excelsis Deo!* Glory to God in the highest. Masses on Easter Sunday continue the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection.

The Holy Feast Days of Easter and Christmas are complementary of one another. We cannot focus on one without recalling the other. One is not complete without the other. We are the recipients of the Greatest Gift that God could give – His only Son.

From His first cry in the manger in Bethlehem to His last cry on the cross of Calvary, He has given us the Gift of His undying love.

I want to extend a warm welcome to all our parishioners, their families and guests, as we celebrate this Feast of the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Christ came to live, to die and now He comes to rise for each of us – making our lives so very blessed and so very important. We were once dead, and now we live because *JESUS CHRIST IS TRULY RISEN TODAY!*

Alleluia! Alleluia!






