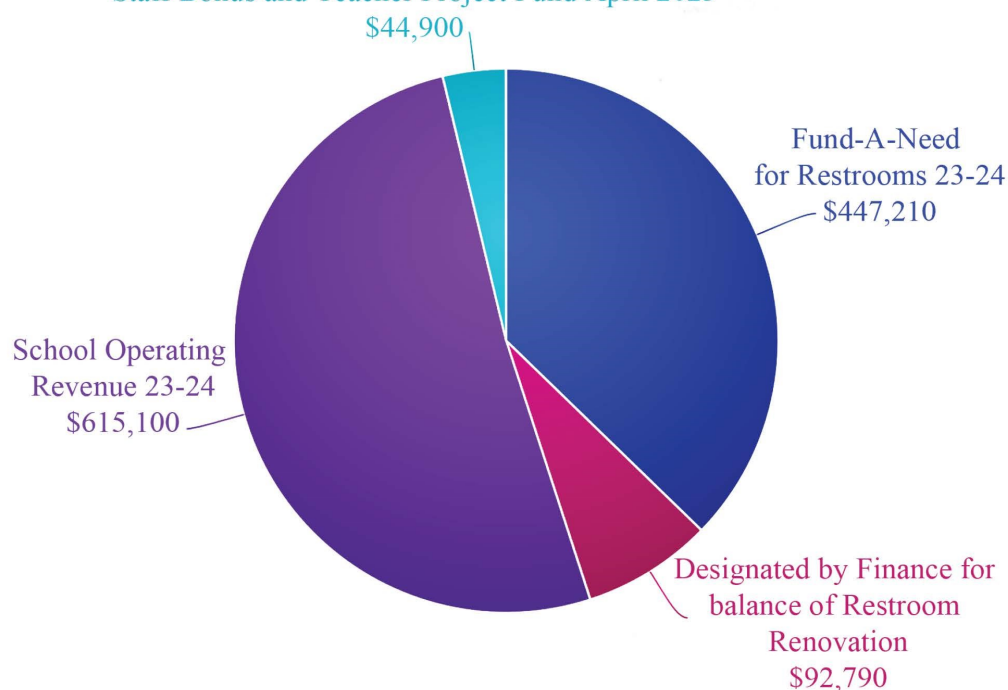

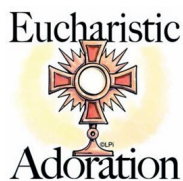
### Eucharistic Adoration

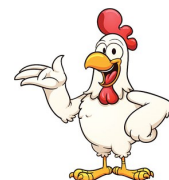

### First Reconciliation

The Sacrament of First Reconciliation is usually received in the 2nd grade for our parish students. 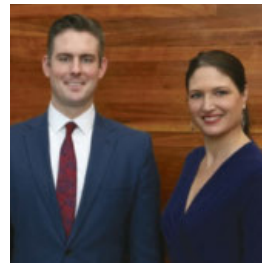

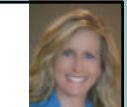

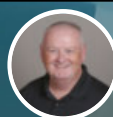
