Invitation to Holiness

For in the warmth of His presence, our lives change. Without Him, everything would truly be gray. Adoring the Body and Blood of Christ, let us ask Him with our heart: "Lord, give me the daily bread to go forward, Lord, satisfy me with your presence!"

These eloquent words spoken by Pope Francis in his Angelus address just over a year ago on June 19, 2022 set the tone for our Eucharistic Revival Movement. In the magnificence of the Eucharist, His Body and Blood, we are nourished and renewed in Christ. We eat, we drink, and we are satisfied! He has given us the greatest Gift ever, the gift of Himself in the Blessed Sacrament.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) through the Eucharistic Revival Movement, issues to each one of us a special invitation to holiness. We are asked to discern how we can be healed, converted, formed and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist.

Thinking of ourselves as the people in the pew, we should keep in mind that we are the parish. Anything that we do to enhance our personal holiness, enhances the holiness of the parish. Today let us touch briefly on some ideas as to how we as individuals can reinvigorate our worship.

This starts long before the beginning of Mass. Can we set aside some time during the week preceding to read and study the readings for the Mass? Can we find (or take) the time to attend daily Mass? Arrive at the church in plenty of time to place yourself in God's presence and think about the awesome event that is about to occur.

Fully and actively participate in the Mass with all your senses engaged. Follow all that is happening on the altar. Make sure those cell phones are muted or turned off so they are not a distraction to yourself or others around you. Be sure to show reverence to Jesus in your dress and actions.

Have you considered volunteering for one of the many liturgical ministries that are needed for each liturgical celebration? These include, but are not limited to servers, sacristans, lectors, ushers, musicians, both vocalists and instrumentalists. Take the God-given gifts you have and ask the Holy Spirit to guide you as to how best to use them.

Next week we will discuss what it means to have a personal encounter with Christ.




