

## HOLY FAMILY HOSPITAL

We welcome Father Ben Shahzad from Pakistan. For many years, Father Ben has been visiting Curé of Ars Church each summer. In that time, Curé has helped repair and renovate the Major Seminary, construct and furnish the St. Pius X Minor Seminary and has provided scholarships for education of poor and needy children in Pakistan. Archbishop Benny Travas of Karachi, hopes we will continue to support their efforts and this year they are making a plea for their only Catholic hospital in the Archdiocese and The Holy Family School of Nursing and Midwifery, Karachi.

The Holy Family Hospital has recently renovated the ER, ICU and a few private rooms making it more welcoming for patients. They are hoping to procure patient beds, baby cots, defibrillators, incubators, and ventilators, to name just a few, to improve patient service areas to ensure a healing environment for all who come through their doors.

The Holy Family School of Nursing and Midwifery is now in the process of upgrading itself to a College level status, which they expect to achieve in the next 2-3 months. They will be offering a Bachelors in Nursing. It will be open to both female and male students. The total tuition for a student for 4 years who will enroll in 2023 will be \$2,895. The tuition, although, cheaper than other areas is still rather steep for the average Christian family of their diocese who are likely to send their children for an education in nursing. They are hoping to create an Endowment Fund that can be used for Scholarships and to help maintain the quality of education at the College of Nursing.

"We have taken a definitive step to the restoration of our beloved and only Catholic hospital of the Archdiocese of Karachi and its attached Nursing School. We pray that our energy will be supported in good faith with essential funds to be able to carry out these renovations and upgrades. The list given is only part of what we require, but we would be profoundly grateful for whatever we can receive for it and we look forward to the generosity of the Cure of Ars Parish to assist us in our mission. Thanking you and sending our prayers. May God bless you and your parishioners."






