Catechist Corner

As part of the parish's response to the Eucharistic Revival, we will be taking a "Walk through the Holy Mass" simplified in question and answer form for the next several weeks to learn more about this gift given to us by God.

What is the Mass?

One way to describe the Holy Mass is that it is Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday made sacramentally present in ritual. At every Holy Mass, bread and wine are changed (transubstantiation) into Christ's Body and Blood, the Body which died on the cross and the Blood which was shed for our sins, now glorified in heaven. This is called the Eucharist. The Eucharist is a meal but not just any meal to remind us of something that happened a long time ago at the Last Supper. The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word *eucharistia*, meaning thanksgiving. The Holy Mass re-presents the same sacrifice of Jesus on the cross and we give praise and thanksgiving to God for the gift of our salvation. The Catechism of the Catholic

Church describes the Eucharist as the "Source and Summit" of the Christian Life (1324-1327). It is the source of grace and strength that allows us to carry out the work of the Church, and it is the summit because all activity of the Church should be directed towards the Eucharist.

Where did the word, Mass, come from?

The name comes from the Latin word *missa*. In Latin, Mass ends *with Ite missa est*, which translated into English means "Go, it is sent." The "it" seems to mean the Church. The Mass thus gets its name from the word, *missa* in the dismissal at the end. Sometime after 604 AD the word, Mass, was applied to the entire liturgy. Before his ascension, the Risen Lord gave the Great Commission (Matt.28:19-20) to his disciples to go out to all the world and preach the Gospel. As Christians we are called to gather and worship by attending Holy Mass at least every Sunday and holy day and then to follow the words at the final dismissal, "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord" or "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life."
