Catechist Corner - Why do Catholics do that?

We are called to "full and active participation" in the Holy Mass (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*) which involves intentionally acting in unison with the entire congregation. As Catholics, we enter the church and dip our hand into holy water (which has been blessed by a priest, bishop, or deacon) and make the sign of the cross. Each part of the Holy Mass has a different posture. During Mass, we genuflect, kneel, sit, stand, and sing during the liturgy. Sometimes we do this out of habit but there are good reasons for this.

Why do we dip our hand into holy water & make the sign of the cross?

The Sign of the Cross reminds us to whom we belong: The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. By dipping our hand into holy water and making the Sign of the Cross, we are also reminded of our entrance into the Church through Baptism. It is for this reason that the placement of holy water is typically close to the entrance of the worship space. Baptism is also "the gateway to life in the Spirit, and the door which gives access to other sacraments" so that one can receive the Eucharist. (CCC 1213)

Why do we genuflect?

In medieval Europe, it was a custom to go down on one knee before a king or person of high rank. This practice gradually entered the Church recognizing that Jesus is the King of Kings and He is truly present in the Eucharist.

Why do we kneel?

Kneeling is a sign of humility and penitence. When we kneel, we are humbly worshiping and surrendering ourselves to our Heavenly Father.

Why do we sit?

Sitting is a posture of listening, learning, and waiting. We sit when we are listening to the first two readings during Mass and learning about the readings in the homily. We also remain seated while waiting for the Eucharistic elements to be prepared, a very meaningful gesture because then we stand when the priest is ready.

Why do we stand?

Standing is the posture that expresses respect, honor, and attentiveness and our readiness to carry out the Word of God.

Why do we sing?

God has given us music as a gift for our expression. We sing to unite our voices in a common expression and together we lift our hearts up to God.

Next week we will learn more about the Greeting in the Introductory Rites.




