

Catechist Corner - Liturgy of the Word, Part 2

After the Gospel, we sit to listen attentively to the homily. Then, we stand to profess our Catholic faith by reciting the Creed and petition God through the Universal Prayer.

Who can give the homily and what is its purpose?

Homilies are different than speeches. A homily is given by an ordained bishop, priest, or deacon and is only preached at liturgies (e.g., Mass, Baptisms, Confirmations, weddings, funerals, and ordinations). The homily will typically use texts from the Scripture readings that have just been proclaimed as a framework to help the congregation understand how to grow closer to God and as an encouragement to stay strong in the faith. It might also challenge us, but the purpose is to help form our consciences and direct us in the way we should live. On any given Sunday, Catholics around the world will hear the same Mass readings, but the homily may be very different from one homilist to another.

What is the meaning and history of the Creeds?

After the homily, we stand to recite the Nicene or Apostles' Creed. The word creed comes from the Latin word credo, meaning "I believe." Even though the two creeds are different, they both express a belief in our Catholic faith. The Apostles' Creed is referred to as a faithful summary of the Apostles' faith and was originally used as a baptismal creed beginning in the second century. At the heart of the Nicene Creed is the confession of Jesus Christ as consubstantial with the Father and was first articulated in 325 at the first ecumenical Council of Nicaea in response to the heresy of Arianism which denied that Jesus was God. The statements after "I believe in the Holy Spirit" that we say today, were added at the Council of Constantinople (381) and so technically speaking the Nicene Creed as we know it today is the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed. The Roman Missal permits the option of using the Apostles' Creed instead of the Nicene Creed. However, the Nicene Creed is more often recited at Holy Mass because it is a more detailed profession of our faith.

What are the other common names for the Universal Prayer and what are we generally praying for?

The other common names for the Universal Prayer are the Prayer of the Faithful, Petitions or Bidding Prayers. These prayers usually fall into four categories: the Church, nations and their leaders, people who are in special need, and the local needs of the parish. The priest usually begins the Universal Prayer with a brief introduction and concludes with a formal prayer. The petitions are announced, and the congregation is given an opportunity to respond with "Lord, hear our prayer" or something similar. As we anticipate approaching the altar to receive the Eucharist, we are praying together as the Body of Christ because we believe that God hears our prayers and will work through His people to bring healing and salvation to the world.

Next week, we will learn more about the Liturgy of the Eucharist.



Youth Choir




