

Liturgy of the Eucharist, Concluding Rite

We have now received the Body of Christ so that we may become the Body of Christ.

What is the purpose of the blessing?

The priest or deacon raises his hands over the congregation. The purpose of this action is to call upon God to grant us the grace to be strengthened in the spiritual life and renewed in our mission to spread the Gospel. The priest or deacon prays: "May almighty God bless you, the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit." We respond, "Amen."

What does the dismissal mean?

After the blessing, the priest or deacon dismisses the people. In fact, the dismissal gives the liturgy its name. The word "Mass" comes from the Latin word, "Missa." At one time, these Latin words were used in the blessing, "Ite, missa est" literally meaning "Go, she (meaning you, the Church) has been sent." The word "Missa" is related to the word "missio," the root of the English word "mission". Having just received Jesus Christ in Word and in Sacrament, we are now being commissioned to go forth and bring Jesus Christ into the world.

What is our response to the dismissal?

The priest or deacon says these words or something similar, "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life." Our response is always the same, "Thanks be to God." With our words, we are giving our "yes" that we will respond to the Gospel by living out the grace of the Eucharist in our daily lives.

When does the Mass officially end?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains that "the liturgy in which the mystery of salvation is accomplished concludes with the sending forth (mission) of the faithful, so that they may fulfill God's will in their daily lives." (CCC 1332)

Does the Mass ever really end?

The Mass doesn't just end with a dismissal. We as the people of God should not simply go about our daily routine and forget that we were "sent". Rather we are challenged to go forth and bring Jesus Christ to a hurting world who needs Him.

How should we exit the church?

We may leave after the priest exits the sanctuary. However, we may also stay for a while to thank God for the great gift of the Eucharist. The church should remain a quiet place of prayer out of respect for Jesus and for those who are praying. Therefore, while it is good to fellowship with our friends, we should exit the church quietly and visit with them outside of the sanctuary.

This concludes the series on "A Walk through the Mass" simplified in question-and-answer form.






