

The Catechist Corner

How Should a Catholic Prepare to Receive Holy Communion?

The Catholic Church sets out ordinary guidelines regarding how we should prepare ourselves to receive the Lord's body and blood in Holy Communion. Please note there may be exceptions to these guidelines, e.g., at the hour of death or for those with intellectual disabilities.

Be in a state of grace and have confessed any mortal sins in Confession (Can. 916).

Believe in the doctrine of transubstantiation, meaning that the bread and wine are transformed into the actual body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ, and only the appearances of bread and wine remain.

Observe the Eucharistic fast. Canon law states, "One who is to receive the most Holy Eucharist is to abstain from any food or drink, with the exception only of water and medicine, for at least the period of one hour before Holy Communion" (Can. 919 §1). Elderly people, those who are ill, and their caretakers are excused from the Eucharistic fast (Can. 191 §3).

Why Are Non-Catholics Unable to Receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church?

It is often uncomfortable for Catholics who must explain to non-Catholics why they can't ordinarily receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church. The main reasons have to do with unity and belief in the Real Presence.

The guidelines for receiving Holy Communion are issued by the U.S. bishops and is explained this way, "Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Communion" (Guidelines for the Reception of Communion, NCCB 1996).

In Scripture, we see that partaking of the Eucharist is a sign of Christian unity: "Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread" (1 Cor. 10:17). For this reason, to do so would be to proclaim a unity to exist that, regrettably, does not.

Another reason that non-Catholics may not ordinarily receive Communion is for their own protection since many reject the doctrine of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Scripture warns that it is dangerous for one not believing in the Real Presence to receive Communion: "For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment upon himself" (1 Cor. 11:29).

Non-Catholics and Catholics not receiving Holy Communion may receive a blessing from a priest or deacon in the communion line by crossing their arms over their chest. Catholics who are not prepared to receive the Eucharist are encouraged to make a spiritual communion by praying an act of faith, desire, and thanksgiving.


