Jubilee Year of Hope

2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year, the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home. Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope."

The Catholic Church celebrates a Jubilee Year every 25 years, offering unique opportunities to receive special graces. This event is celebrated both in Rome and in our local dioceses in communion with the universal Catholic Church. Rome's holy doors are opened, specific feast days are celebrated in Rome and numerous pilgrimages are offered to gather Catholics.

Several opportunities for spiritual growth and to share the Good News of Jesus Christ will be offered in the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. This includes an offering of plenary indulgences, such as a pilgrimage to the Cathedral of St. Peter. Archbishop Naumann is also encouraging local opportunities and invites you to prayerfully consider how you (and your family) can participate in the Year of Jubilee to grow as missionary disciples, strengthen marriages and families, and to engage as Pilgrims of Hope in this 2025 Jubilee. Curé of Ars will be hosting a series of hope-filled conversion testimonies after a Rosary, Novena, and Holy Mass on Tuesdays during Lent. We hope you will join us!

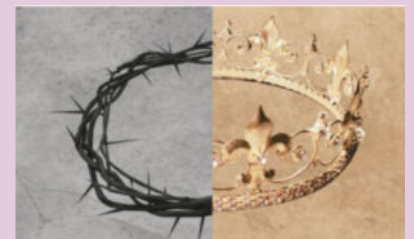
