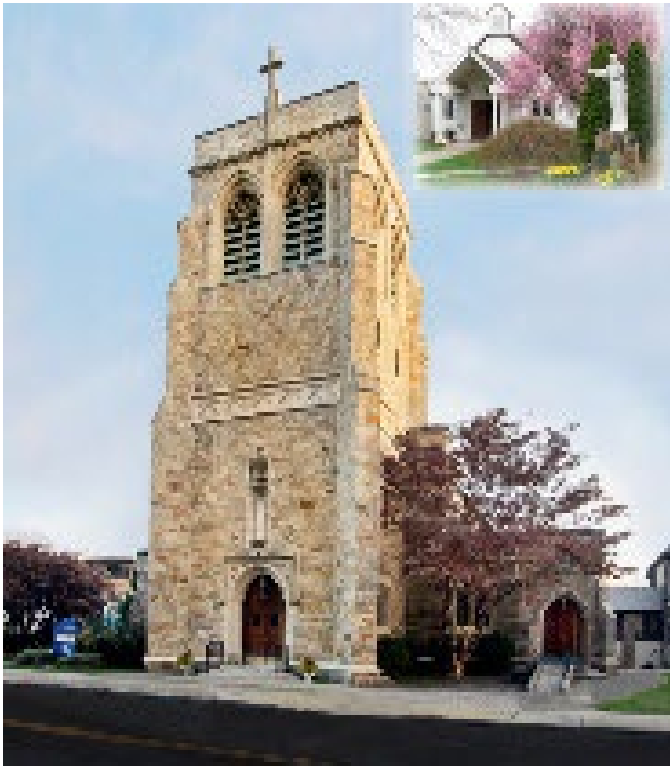

Message from Village Manager Healy

The Village of Croton on Hudson recently adopted a local law to increase the income eligibility for the senior property tax exemption from \$29,000 to \$50,000/year. In order to receive the exemption, residents must file an application with the Village Assessor each year. The deadline for submitting an application is December 31st. To qualify for the exemption, seniors must meet certain residency, age, income, and ownership requirements. For more information, please call the Village Assessor's Office at 914- 271-4783.

From the Pastor's Desk

October 30, 2022

My Dear Parishioners,

This week we will celebrate the Feast of All Saints. We may not truly know who a saint is, so let's make it clear. A saint is one who has attained heaven by having lived their faith in Jesus Christ and the Church with utmost fidelity and in a heroic manner. Every follower of Christ has promised on the day of their confirmation to live the faith even unto death. There may be billions of faithful Christians who have attained heaven and who are saints, but the Church focuses on the known saints that are listed in the canon of the saints in the Catholic church. All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation, and all Catholics are obliged to attend Church except in the case of illness. This feast is also commemorated by the Eastern Orthodox Church, the Lutheran, and the Anglican churches as well. The feast of All Saints was formally started by Pope Boniface IV who consecrated the Pantheon of Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the Martyrs on May 13 in 609 AD. He also established All Souls Day, which is the day after All Saints Day.

A saint is what every Christian is called to be. Not to live the faith or to live it half-heartedly is to place other things or persons as more important in our lives. A saint is one who dares to travel through the narrow gate that is Jesus Christ because he is the gate of the sheepfold. We are privileged to have seen and witnessed the lives of Mother Teresa and Pope John Paul II who passed on to heaven a few years ago.

There can be no greater fulfillment for a Christian than to strive to be a saint.

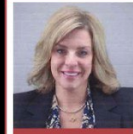
