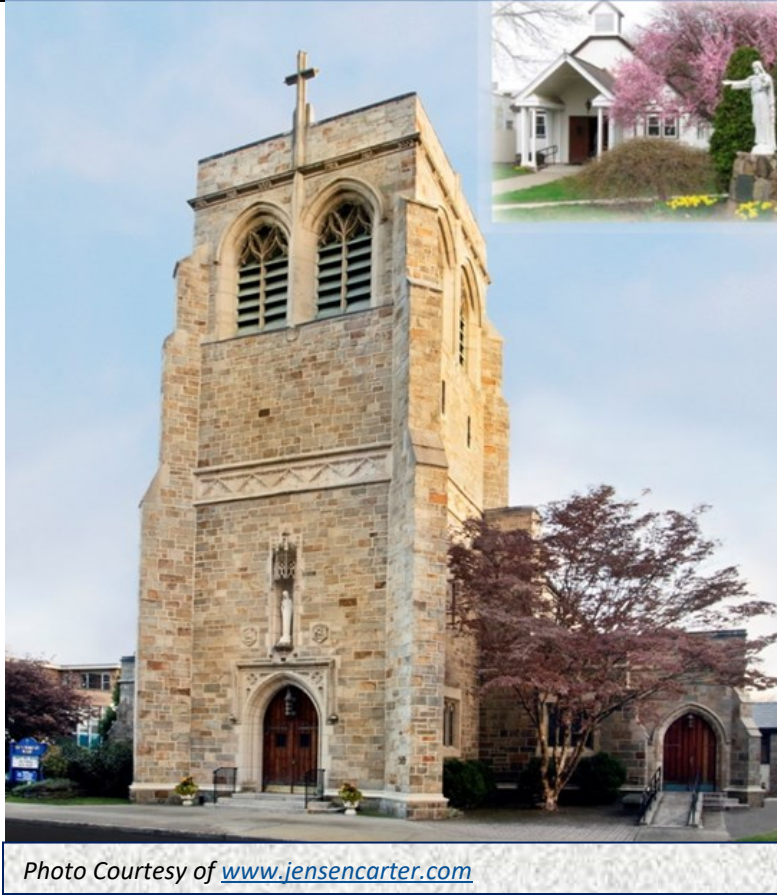

### Coming in October at HNM!

#### Christology Class

Fr. Ron will be teaching a class on Christology every Wednesday in October! Classes begin October 1st at 7PM in the Parish Meeting Room. (Enter through the rear door off the parking lot.)

2. The Mysteries of Christ, beginning with the Mystery of the Incarnation
3. The Mystery of Redemption
4. The Mystery of the Resurrection
5. Christ in His Church
