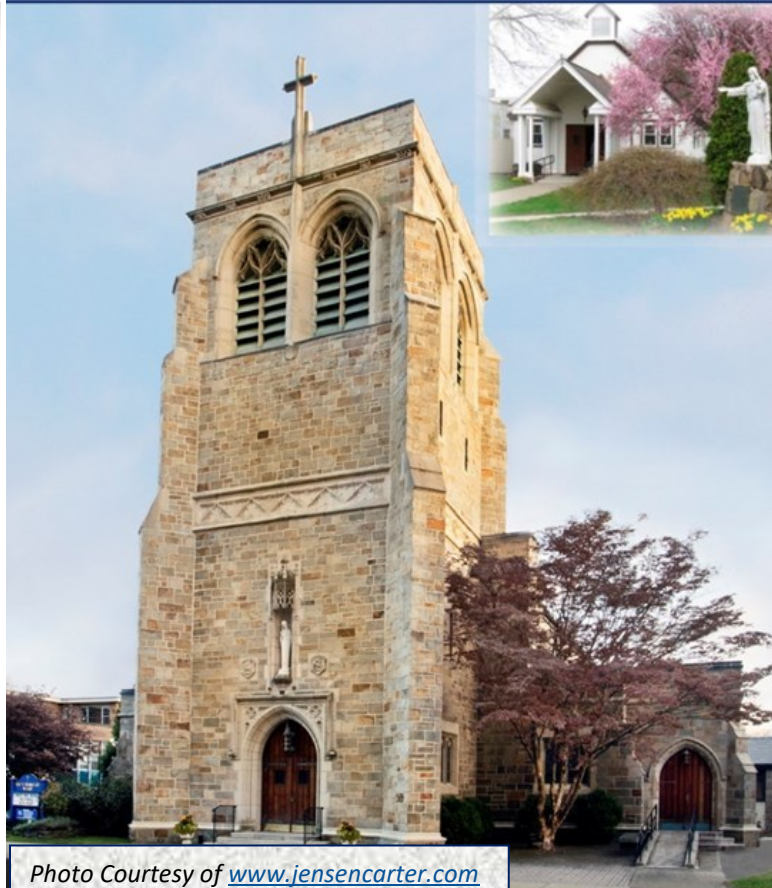

Sacramental Requirements

Parishioners: You should register to be a parishioner under your own name at 18 years of age, whether or not you live with your parent/guardians.

Sponsors: You must be a registered parishioner, under your own name for at least 6 months in order to request a sponsor form for Baptism or Confirmation.

Marriage: You must begin the preparation process with the Pastor at least 6 months prior to your wedding date.

Baptism: Parents must be registered parishioners and attend a mandatory baptism class. Godparents need to obtain sponsor eligibility forms from the parish they attend.

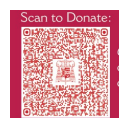

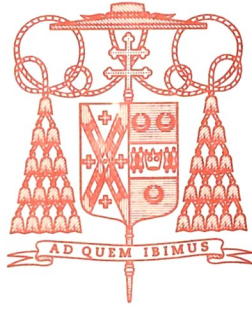
